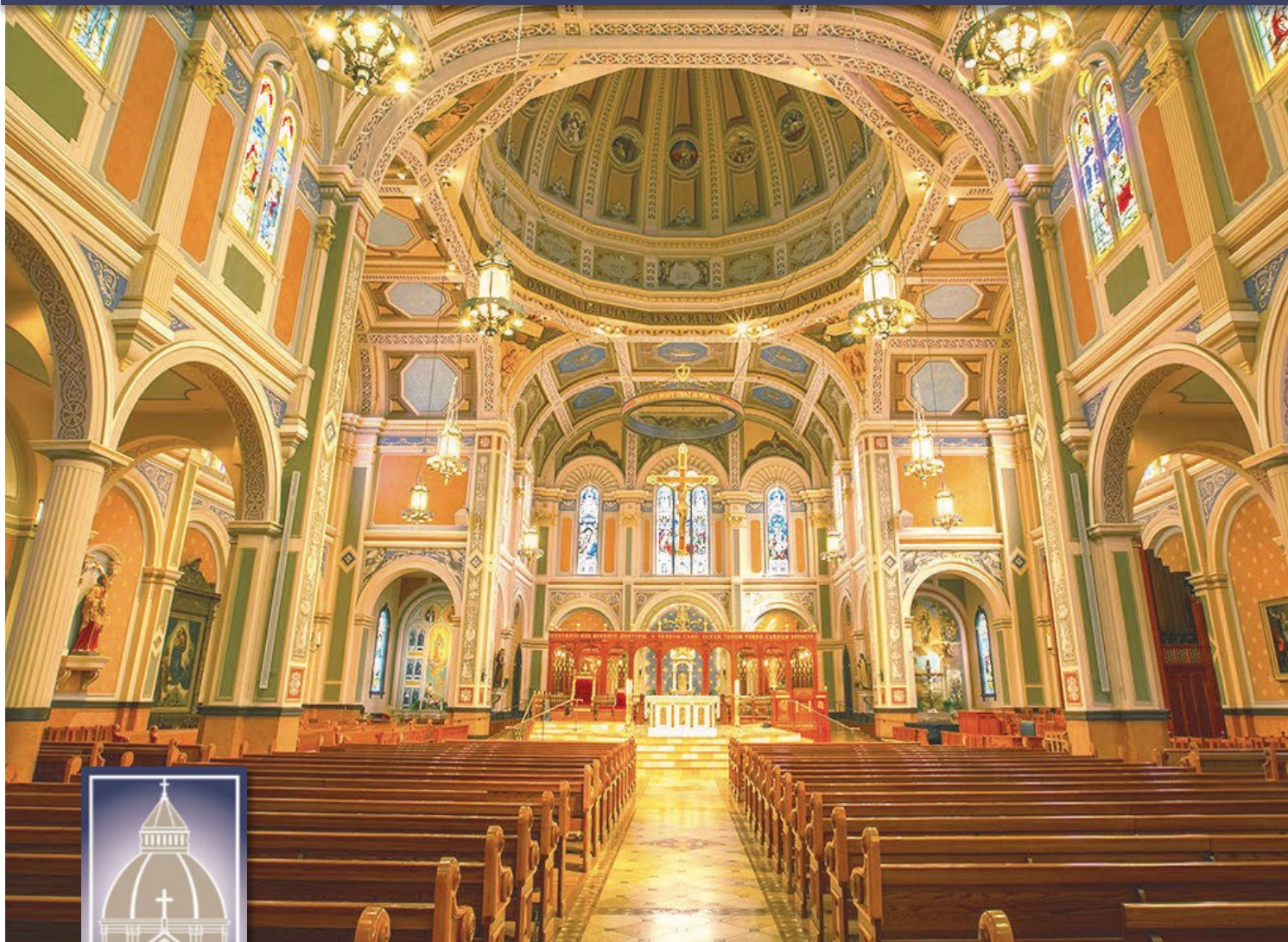

## STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today's readings at the Cathedral are special for us as we celebrate the Anniversary of Dedication of Cathedral. As you follow along in the liturgical year, today's gospel is from Luke. This teaching is important as we continue to follow Christ. Today's gospel takes us back to the basics, inviting us to reflect honestly on our deepest priorities in life.

In the Gospel, from Luke, Christ refers to the struggle to put Him above all else as He encounters two "would be" disciples on His way to Jerusalem. "Follow me," Jesus says to the first man. "But he replied, 'Lord let me go first and bury my father.' The other said, "I will follow you, Lord, but first let me say farewell to my family at home." These two want to follow Christ but only on their own terms, only after taking care of some other, more pressing matters (at least in their own minds).

To this, Christ says thanks but no thanks! Following Him requires an unqualified "yes" not a "yes but..." We are called to put Christ and His kingdom ahead of our own plans if we truly wish to be his disciples and to find victory in the battle of selfishness.

Living stewardship as a way of life can go a long way in arming us for victory. Stewardship living provides us with a custom-made "training plan" — the commitment to a specific offering of our time, talent, and treasure to the Kingdom of God. It is a plan discerned through prayer and by looking at the realities of our unique circumstances, strengths, and limitations. The daily discipline of committing to the plan strengthens us and helps us gradually move away from the "yes, but" attitude and towards an unqualified "yes!" to Christ and His will.

Do not be afraid to give the best of yourself and your gifts to Christ. He deserves nothing less. And this way of life, while challenging, will be characterized by a joy and peace that only comes from living for Him.

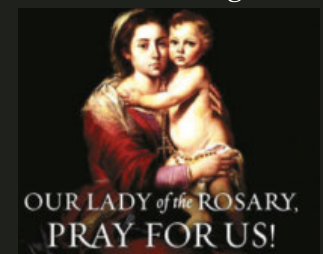

## ANNIVERSARY OF DEDICATION OF CATHEDRAL

The Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament is considered one of three of the most historically significant buildings in Sacramento. Built at time when Sacramento was transitioning from a mining town into a capitol city, it took the kind of dedication and fortitude for which the early pioneer's of California were known. *Pictured Bishop Manogue*



In 1889, The Bishop, aware of the decadence of the mining towns, gave a full representation of places, people and population. After two years his maps and letters induced the authorities in Rome to grant his petition, to remove Sacramento from the Archdiocese (San Francisco) and make it the new diocese of Sacramento.

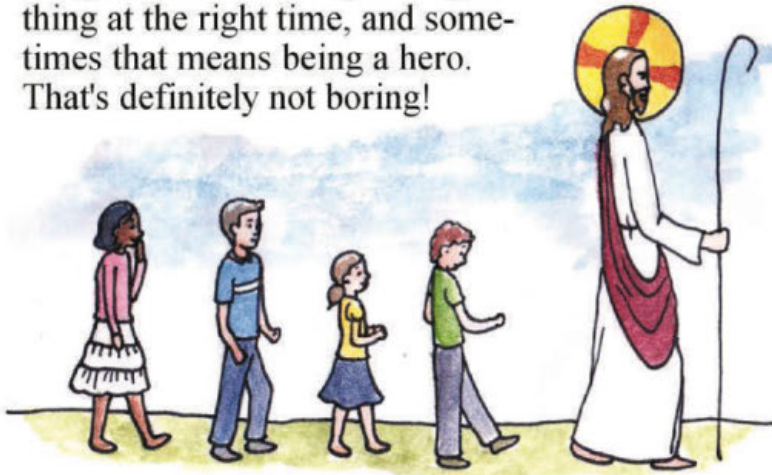


## Follow Jesus

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus asks some people to leave everything behind and follow Him. God is actually asking all of us to follow Him! Does that mean that we have to start wandering from town to town preaching? No! It means that we should try to become holy like Jesus.

God calls everyone to be holy. Some people become holy as priests or religious sisters or brothers, but those are not the only ways to become holy. Kids, married people and single people can all live out God's plan for holiness by doing His will every day.

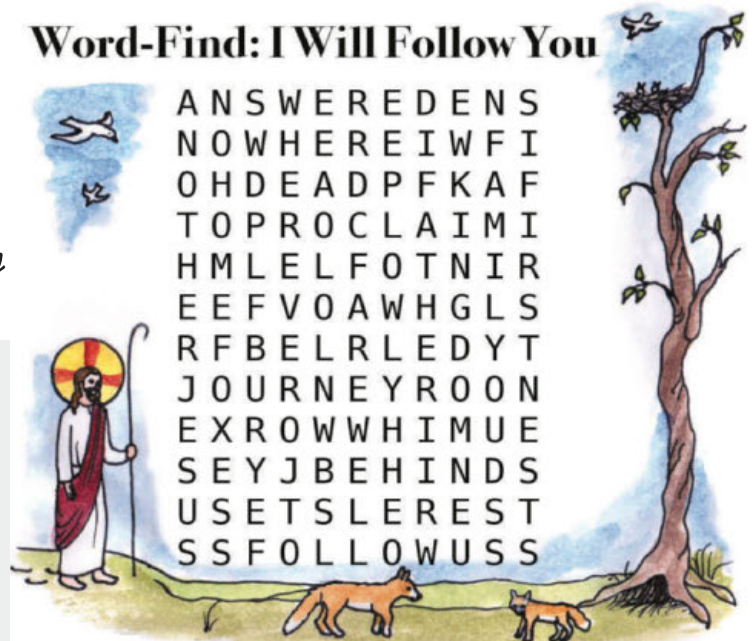

## A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥28

See God as God, see human as human; and see you as you. This is the real human life.

When people see God as nothing, see others as air, and see themselves as gods, the world is in chaos. All cases of great chaos come from human self-centeredness.

Jesus said, "Beware of practicing your piety before people in order to be seen by them; for then you will have no reward from your Father who is in heaven."

First of all, Jesus asked believers to "beware" (prosechete). This verb means taking heed lest one do a thing. What Jesus insists is being pretend.

The "piety" practiced by Christians here is the Greek term "justice" (dikaiosynēn). It bears the meaning of integrity, virtue, purity of life, uprightness and correctness in thinking, feeling, and acting. Therefore, if the gift of God is packaged with self-centeredness, it is stealing the glory of God. That is what Jesus means by the verb "pretend."

In order to be seen by others while doing piety, it is to show off one's own so-called holiness. Since there is no God in his/her heart, God cannot give any "reward."

The "reward" (misthon) is not a material prize but the grace of God, in other words, the kingdom of heaven.

All who take the advantage of God as to glorify them, Jesus called these people hypocrites (hypokritai). To put it bluntly, they are acting. Doing good deeds is simply a drama for them. They are actually eating sugar-coated poison. At the beginning, it is always a little sweet and seductive; but in the end, they will die in hell forever. This drama is the biggest tragedy.

Seeing life through the will of God is not worth sacrificing eternal life for temporary glory.

看天主是天主，看人是人，看自己是自己

大亂，因為自我中心，做一切事，都為自己利益，不管他人死活

耶穌說：“你們應當心，不要在人前行你們的仁義，為叫他們看見；若是這樣，你們在天父之前，就沒有賞報了。”

首先，耶穌要信徒“當心”（prosechete）意即小心別做一件事，跟著耶穌就講清楚是什麼，就是不要裝假。

“行仁義”的“仁義”（dikaiosynēn）是來自天主的正直、美德、純潔以及正確思想、情感和行為。因此，如果將天主賜予的禮物，換上自我中心來包裝，這就是偷竊天主的光榮，就是裝假。

為叫人看見，是表現自己神聖，既然心中無主，天主就沒辦法給任何“賞報”。

“賞報”（misthon）不是物質獎品，而是天主恩寵，即天國。

所有利用天主來光榮自己的，耶穌都稱他們是假善人（hypokritai），即偽裝者或偽君子，說白，是演戲。

做好人行好事，為他們都是一場戲，骨子裡是讓自己光耀人前，如吃糖衣毒藥，剛開始總是有點甜蜜勾引，最終是永遠死在地獄裡面，這場戲，是最大悲劇。

從天意看透人生，不值得為暫時風光，而斷送永恆生命
