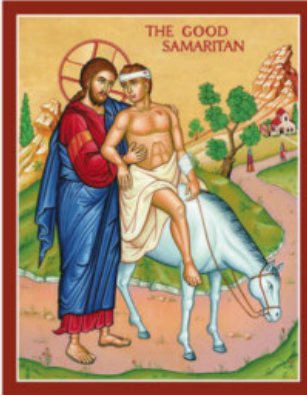

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STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION



In today's Gospel passage, from Luke, we read the well-known parable of the Good Samaritan. Here, Jesus teaches in rich detail what stewardship in action looks like. In fact, this parable could just as accurately be called the parable of the Good Steward.

The first thing we note about the Good Samaritan is that he is aware of the needs of those around him and responds generously. While the priest and Levi brush right past the man on the side of the road, the Samaritan is watching for those who might be in need. He has a hospitable way of looking at the world around him and so he is able to "see" in a way that the others did not, and he was "moved with compassion at the sight" of the man.

Next, we see the Good Samaritan spring into action to serve this man, setting aside his own schedule and plans to meet his needs. He does not just give the man a few dollars or offer quick words of encouragement from across the road. He goes right up to the man. He cleans and bandages his wounds. He puts the man on his own animal and brings him to an inn where he can heal. He ensures the innkeeper would continue to look after him, and he commits to returning to the man on his way back.

That is how we live out God's commandments. That is true hospitality and service. That is how a good steward springs into action when he comes upon a neighbor in need. And Jesus says to each of us personally, just as He did in today's Gospel, "Go and do likewise."

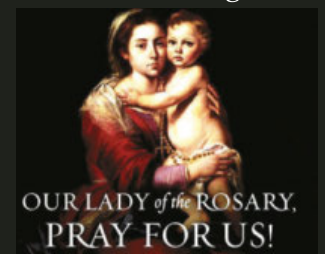

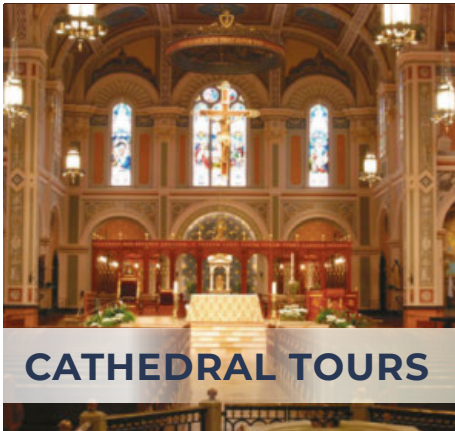

Question: *Dear Jesus, if I love the Lord, my God, with all my heart, with all my being, with all my strength, and with all my mind, how would I have any remaining love for which to love my neighbor or myself?*

Response: *Rightfully, you would have no extra love for neighbor or self. However, loving the Lord is not easily accomplished. Often the effort to love God with one's entire being becomes subverted into love of self. What looks like a holy, pious life in love with the Lord is often a selfish life in love with self. Efforts to seek union with God can easily become efforts of self-interest and self-love. This is why the attempt to love God without the love of neighbor leads only to a love of self. This is to be expected. Once you realize how much your efforts are truly about a love of yourself, you must now offer that love to your neighbor. Only then will you accomplish loving the Lord with your entire being.*

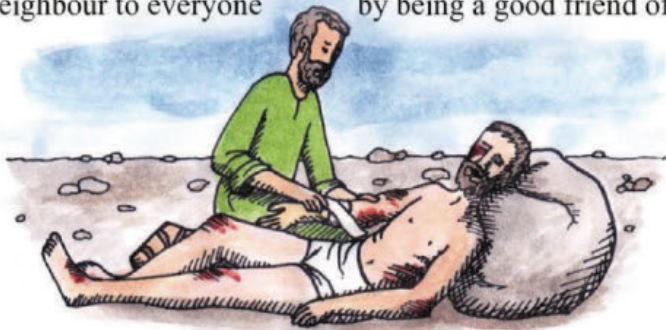
Loving God and Our Neighbour

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥30

Being betrayed is a great hurt, not because of money issue, but because of destroying mutual trust. It turns out that trust is very important in people's hearts, for instances, making people feel comfortable and confident in their lives, and there is no need to doubt ceaselessly everyone and everything.

Are the betrayed miserable? Or, are the traitors more miserable?

Usually, after being betrayed, people can get back on their feet and learn a valuable lesson in life. As a matter of fact, whoever betrays others is betraying his/her own life, especially when Judas who betrayed Jesus. On the surface, Jesus was crucified to death by Judas' betrayal. Nevertheless, Judas lost the kingdom of heaven forever as Jesus said, "The Son of man goes as it is written of him, but woe to that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! It would have been better for that man if he had not been born." (Matt 26:24)

Jesus also quoted Ps 41:9 to illustrate his tolerance for Judas: "Even my bosom friend in whom I trusted, who ate of my bread, has lifted his heel against me."

Jesus trusted Judas but Judas betrayed him. However, Jesus still treated Judas as his beloved disciple at the farewell supper, asking Judas to sit beside him: "So when he had dipped the morsel, he gave it to Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot." (John 13:26)

Jesus finally indicated the result of anyone who betrays God: "and he who receives me receives him who sent me." That is to say, those who betray Jesus, betray also the Father.

The verb "receive" (*lambanōn*) means to accept or seize. Here it points to the accommodation offered to Jesus. Receiving Jesus, at the same time, is to receive the Father because he and the Father are one. In other words, when Judas betrayed Jesus, he betrayed the Father and ultimately, his own eternal life.

The ability to accept Jesus is not the humans' greatness but God's mercy.

耶穌說：“人子固然要按照指著他所記載的而去，但是出賣人子的那人卻是有禍的！那人若是沒有生，為他更好。”（瑪26:24）

耶穌也引用聖詠41:10來說明他對猶達斯的包容：“連我素來信賴的知心友好，吃過我飯的人，也舉腳踢我。”

耶穌信賴猶達斯，猶達斯卻出賣耶穌，耶穌依然在臨別晚餐當中，請猶達斯坐他身旁：“耶穌就蘸了一片餅，遞給加略人西滿的兒子猶達斯。”（若13:26）

耶穌說明出賣他的結果：“接待我的，就是接待那派遣我來的。”

“接待”（*lambanōn*）本意接受或抓住，意思是接納耶穌，接納耶穌也就是接納天父，因為他與父原是一體。換言之，猶達斯出賣耶穌，也就是出賣天父，出賣天父，最終是出賣自己的永生。

接納耶穌的能力，不是人的偉大，而是天主給人的慈悲
