STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today's readings on this fifth Sunday of Easter contain inspiring but challenging messages for us Christian stewards.

The Gospel from John includes this well-known verse: "My children...I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another."

What a succinct description of a stewardship way of life. It sounds so simples. But simple does not necessarily mean easy.

How exactly is Jesus Calling us to love? As He, Himself loved. Jesus loved (and loves) by serving us and by making a sacrifice of His very life for us. That is a tall order.

Living a life of service and self-sacrifice is not easy because it requires us to continuously fight against our selfish inclinations. But the more we empty ourselves of "self" by serving others, the more room we make in our hearts for God to pour His grace into us. Amazingly, the more we give our lives away to others, the more He fills us up with Himself who is love itself.

And amid the inevitable challenging moments this way of life entails we can be assured that the Lord who loves us so much that He died for us and established the Eucharist to be our strength and nourishment, is right here with us every step of the way. As we face the hardships that come with living as Christian stewards, we can continue to rejoice in the wonder of the Resurrection this Easter season, finding great joy in following in our Lord's footsteps and in loving as He loves.





A Glimpse of Spirituality (靈修一瞥) 22

Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

Faced with witnessing truth and justice, many people, including good ones, are discouraged because of fear. There are many sources of fear, for instances, fear of offending the authorities, fear of being rejected by others, and more importantly, fear of being persecuted as well. Thus, witnessing Jesus being arrested, Peter denied Jesus three times because of fear (John 18:17, 25, 27).

The gospel states: "Some of the people of Jerusalem therefore said: Is not this the man whom they seek to kill? And here he is, speaking openly, and they say nothing to him! Can it be that the authorities really know that this is the Christ?"

Jesus continued to speak boldly in the face of crucifixion.

The verb "kill" (apokteinai) can also be interpreted as destroying. To kill Jesus is to destroy his existence and also everything he did, i.e. to cut off the influence of Jesus in the world.

"Speaking openly" (parrēsia) denotes freedom and openness. Especially in speech, it means boldness and confidence.

In the face of a brutal death, Jesus spoke boldly and confidently, because he is the truth (cf. John 14:6) and the one who sent him, with no doubt, must be the truth as Jesus said, "But I have not come of my own accord; he who sent me is true, and him you do not know."

"He who sent me is true" (estin alēthinos ho) can be understood as the one who is authentically true, emphasizing that the Father himself is the truth. Jesus is sent by the Father who is true, thus, what he reveals is the truth.

The truth even somehow is destroyed by the devil; however, the truth is eternal while the devil's attack is only temporary. Though the opponents of Jesus killed him in order to destroy the truth, the devil will one day be destroyed. It is because, destruction of truth is self-destruction.

耶穌面對殺害,繼續放膽講論

"殺害"(apokteinai)也可以解作毀滅,殺害耶穌,是要毀滅他的存在,以及他所作的一切,就是將耶穌給世界帶來的影響,切斷。 "放膽"(parrēsia)原意是"公開",意即自由與開放,放在言論方面,則表示大膽與自信。

耶穌面對殘酷死亡,依然大膽自信宣講,因為他是真理(參若14:6),派遣他的,毫無疑問,是真理: "但我不是由我自己而來,而是那真實者派遣我來的。"

"真實者"(estin alēthinos ho, the one who is true),強調天父本身就是真理,耶穌被祂派遣,講論的,一定是真理,真理在邪理面前,永恆,因為邪理終有一天自我毀滅,雖然邪惡的人為了毀滅真理而殺死耶穌。


