STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

In today's Gospel passage, from Luke, we find our Lord appointing disciples to go out and prepare others to receive His invitation into the Kingdom of God. Every verse has something to say about the way a Christian steward should approach others. Let's consider at least one of the coaching tips Christ gives.

"The Lord appointed seventy-two others whom He sent out ahead of Him in pairs to every town and place He intended to visit." In His wisdom, Christ sent His disciples out not as individuals but in pairs, as teams. This approach to evangelization certainly provided practical advantages. The disciples could lean on each other for mutual support and encouragement, helping each other to stay on task and to put their heads together to pray and problem-solve. This teamwork approach is just as relevant to us modern-day Christian stewards. It takes courage and commitment to go out and invite others into the Christian life. We need to work together to do it well.

But there is also symbolic importance to working in teams. It points to the reality that when we invite others to embrace the Good News of the Gospel, we are not merely inviting them into a belief system, but into a relationship with Christ and through that relationship, into Christ's family — our fellow Christian disciples near and far.

Our parish is our immediate spiritual family in this extended worldwide fold. We are not meant to live as isolated individuals within the parish any more than we are meant to live in isolation within our families. We are meant to be a community. That is why it is so important for us to foster a vibrant, supportive, welcoming parish life. This is why we emphasize hospitality as one of the pillars of stewardship. It is not enough just to point others to Christ; we must invite them to join us in community with Him; we must offer a place and mission for them in the Church and within our parish family.

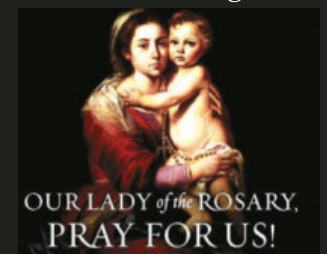

Parents – one meeting a month, parents will receive instruction on the month’s topic while children are instructed in their groups; families will rejoin together for activities. One second meeting of the month will focus on building community.

Students – once a month will participate in class with a catechist, and work side by side with their parents to complete a series of activities. The second session each month is a community activity. In between each session, suggested home activities will be part of child’s faith experience.

Catechists – will meet with the children providing additional support as they prepare to receive their sacrament.

Parents – Will lead their children in completing the “at home” activities.

Students – Will be responsible for developing their prayer life and keep up their spiritual journey journals.

Your family-assigned catechist – Will be available during the month to support you by answering questions and providing resources.

Children Preparing for Sacraments of Confession, Eucharist, and Confirmation will receive sacramental preparation classes once a month. Children and their Families must be enrolled and participate in faith formation, **A Family of Faith**.

Children and/or Parents needing Baptism, and/or Confirmation and Eucharist can enroll in RCIA for Families. These classes give a introduction to faith to families before instructing in the Sacraments. No former faith formation is required.

“Thus says the Lord: Rejoice with the United States of America and be glad because of her, all you who love her; exult, exult with her, all you who were mourning over her!”

I paraphrase these words from the prophet Isaiah from our first reading this Sunday, which is also our Independence Day weekend. Through the prophet, the Lord speaks of Jerusalem and is referring to the New Jerusalem, the city to be born of the Creator of all. The Lord will give birth to a New City, and will be fondled and cared for, full of peace and prosperity. We do not believe that this New Jerusalem is the United States of America, however, we should certainly see how blessed we are as a country and as a people.

As I write this, the Supreme Court has just overturned *Roe v. Wade* ending the constitutional right to abortion. It is unclear how this decision will improve a U.S. embrace of all life, especially here in California, but those of us concerned about following the will of God and recognizing our need to love and be good stewards of His many gifts, find hope that all of us will be comforted as a “mother comforts her child.”

Being in a country with so many God-given resources, we who follow God are expected to reveal to the world the great gifts that have come from our Maker. As we consider our Independence from the tyranny of man-made ideologies and desires, it's important to remember and reveal that being truly alive and free is found only in union with the Lord. We pray for our beautiful and grace-filled country this weekend, seeking the courage to love as Christ loves and to care for all He has entrusted to us.

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 29

People will get hearing aids when they have hearing problems. However, when the heart and mind are blocked, the voice of God cannot be heard by any hearing aids.

Those who repeatedly asked who Jesus was had already seen the miracles with their eyes that Jesus performed. With their ears, they had also heard Jesus' preaching; however, they still could not accept the fact that Jesus was the Messiah.

They questioned Jesus, "How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Christ, tell us plainly."

The noun "suspense" (aireis) refers to a feeling of entanglement, which contains excitement, fear, hope, joy, or grief. In short, the crowd's impression of Jesus is very vague. Simply, they have no faith. Though Jesus has revealed that he was the Messiah by his words and deeds, and the crowd still seemed to be unable to see or hear.

Jesus said, "The works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness to me."

Everything Jesus did was in the name of the Father. That is to say, the works were entrusted by the Father to Jesus. The term "works" is plural, referring to all the works of Jesus on earth for the glory of the Father, particularly, his incarnation and resurrection. It was the way that the Father who revealed God's eternal love to the world through Jesus. Without God, all miracles and the mysteries of incarnation could not be done on earth. Thus, Jesus emphasized that all works bore witness to him.

"Witness" (martyrei) is to prove that Jesus is the Messiah. As a matter of fact, the crowd really did not put what they saw and heard into their heart and mind; just as Jesus said: "you do not believe, because you do not belong to my sheep."

Unbelief is refusal. The refusal against Jesus is to challenge Jesus. This is the unsteady life under the state of unbelief. Life is steady because with Jesus as our support. What we need to be with Jesus is faith.

聽覺如果發生問題，有助聽器。可是，心靈出現障礙，就聽不到天主聲音

再三再四問耶穌是誰的那些人，眼睛，看過耶穌施行神蹟；耳朵，也聽過耶穌苦口婆心的宣講；可是，心靈就是接納不了耶穌是默西亞。

他們質問耶穌：“你使我們的心神懸疑不安，要到幾時呢？你如果是默西亞，就坦白告訴我們吧！”

“懸疑不安” (aireis) 表示一種五味糾纏的感覺，裡麵包含興奮、恐懼、希望、喜悅或悲傷，換言之，群眾對耶穌的印象，非常模糊，說白，缺乏信德。

耶穌其實早就以言以行，啟示他就是默西亞，群眾依然好像看不見聽不到。

耶穌說：“我以我父的名所作的工作，為我作證。”

耶穌所作的一切，都是因父之名，意即天父委託耶穌所作的工作；“工作” (erga) 是複數，指向耶穌在世所有工作，都是為光榮天父；降生成人以及死亡復活，是天父通過耶穌向世界啟示天主永恆的愛。如果沒有天主，所有神蹟以及降生奧跡，不可能臨在人間，因此耶穌強調所有工作都可以為他作證。

“作證” (martyrei) 就是證明耶穌是默西亞，看出，群眾實在沒有將所見所聞放到心靈體會，正如耶穌說：“但你們還是不信，因為你們不是屬於我的羊。”

不信，就是拒絕，拒絕耶穌，就是要挑戰耶穌，這是人的無信狀態之下的不踏實。

人生踏實，因為有耶穌作依靠，需要的，是信德
