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STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Our readings today call us to pause for a moment and consider how we respond to God's love for us each day.



Our Gospel recounts a dialogue between the Pharisees and Jesus. The Pharisees questioned why Jesus' disciples did not practice the ritual washing before eating a meal.

Jesus' response reminds us to ask ourselves 'why.' Why do we remain faithful to God's commands? Why do we pray or go to Mass? Why do we participate in the sacraments? Why do we love others?

Often, we are living our faith a certain way out of obligation, fear, or duty. But Jesus reminds us that the greatest way to live out our faith is through love. Our faith has obligations to provide us opportunities to love, honor, and praise the Lord. They are meant to aid us on our personal journey with Jesus Christ.

St. James reminds us that every moment of each day is an opportunity to respond to God's infinite love for us with love and gratitude in return.

If we approach our relationship with Jesus with this in mind, then we begin to realize that the gift of the Mass is an opportunity to worship God, the sacraments are ways to draw us closer to Him and His commandments are opportunities to love Him more faithfully.

And if we approach our day-to-day moments with this in mind, then we begin to see just how many blessings God has given us. Looking at life through the lens of gratitude helps us to see each moment as a gift with endless opportunities to respond in love.

This is how we ought to live our lives as Christian stewards — by recognizing our lives as a gift and an opportunity to love God in response to how He has loved us.

STEWARDSHIP AS A WAY OF LIFE

“As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God’s varied grace”

1 Peter 4:10

What is stewardship?

Stewardship is the grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God’s gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor. The U.S. Bishops’ Pastoral Letter on Stewardship states “As Christian stewards, we receive God’s gifts gratefully, cultivate them responsibly, share them lovingly in justice with others, and return them with increase to the Lord.”

STEWARDSHIP BASICS

Three “T’s” of Stewardship—Time, Talent, & Treasure

Stewardship of Time: Using my time on earth wisely; making time for personal prayer, family prayer and quality time with friends and loved ones.

Stewardship of Talent: Using my God-given abilities to strengthen the Church and help others, especially through parish ministries and activities.

Stewardship of Treasure: The wise and just management of my financial resources; giving an appropriate amount of my income to the parish.

The Four Pillars of Parish Stewardship

Building a Stewardship Parish on Four Pillars: Hospitality, Prayer, Formation and Service:

Hospitality – Christian Kindness

“When I was a stranger, you welcomed me” (Matthew 25:35). The Gospel teaches that whenever we welcome the least of our brothers or sisters, we welcome Christ himself. That is why the first mark of a stewardship parish is hospitality.

Prayer – A Heart-to-Heart with God

Every great saint has taught that prayer is the most essential component in the life of the Christian. Through prayer, we nurture our most important relationship — the one that will last for all eternity.

Formation – Continuous Conversion

From childhood through adulthood, our whole life must be a process of drawing closer to God. He never stops calling us forward to learn more and to examine ourselves more deeply.

Service – Love in Action

“Amen I say to you, whatever you did to the least of my brothers, you did it to me” (Matthew 25:40). While we may not view ourselves as saints, we too are called to such heroic service within our own community.



Testimony of Stewardship El Testimonio de Corresponsabilidad

This week...
esta semana


As baptized Catholics, we are called stewards by grace. Baptism makes Christians stewards of this kind, able to act explicitly on God's behalf in cultivating and serving the portion of the world entrusted to their care. Baptism makes them "a royal priesthood" (1 Pt 2:9) called to offer up the world and all that is in it—especially themselves—to the Lord of all. In exercising this office, they most fully realize the meaning of our Christian stewardship. Part of what is involved here for Catholics is a stewardship of time, which should include setting aside periods for family prayer, for the reading of Scripture, for visits to the Blessed Sacrament, and for attendance at Mass during the week whenever this is possible.

How can you in your family live your stewardship—taking care of those entrusted to you?


Como católicos bautizados, somos llamados corresponsabilidad por gracia. El bautismo hace que los cristianos sean mayordomos de este tipo, capaces de actuar explícitamente en nombre de Dios cultivando y sirviendo a la porción del mundo confiada a su cuidado. El bautismo los convierte en "un real sacerdocio" (1 Pe 2, 9) llamados a ofrecer el mundo y todo lo que hay en él —sobre todo ellos mismos— al Señor de todos. Al ejercer este oficio, la mayoría de ellos se dan cuenta del significado de nuestra mayordomía cristiana. Parte de lo que está involucrado aquí para los católicos es una mayordomía del tiempo, que debe incluir reservar períodos para la oración familiar, la lectura de las Escrituras, las visitas al Santísimo Sacramento y la asistencia a la Misa durante la semana siempre que sea posible.

Summer of Faith: The Creed—Week 8

A Review of our Summer of Faith

This Summer we covered a LOT of territory in our look at the Apostles' Creed. If we recite the Creed daily, we place in our conscience the foundations of what the Church teaches. Over the last seven weeks we have explored:

Week One: *What does it mean "To Believe"?*

Week 2: *Created in the Image of God and the Fall of His first Creation*

Week 3: *The Annunciation, The Immaculate Conception and the Incarnation*

Week 4: *Who is Jesus Christ? Jesus Makes us children by Baptism*

Week 5: *The Paschal Mystery and the Last Judgment*

Week 6: *The Holy Spirit and the Church*

Week 7: *The Four Marks of the Church, the Communion of Saints*

In essence, this is the faith we profess each Sunday and it is worth taking to heart, memorizing it, and professing it together as a family. This way, when someone asks you, "What does the Catholic Church stand for, you can tell them what you believe and help others to find Jesus in the Church's teachings.

APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried, He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God, the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Give it all Back

Pop culture has given us a unique idea of the term justice. Justice, we often think, is about taking. Taking what's owed. Taking revenge. Taking what we deserve. This worldview tends to make mincemeat of our Catholic social teachings. Seeking the good of the poor, a call to community and participation, solidarity — on the face of it, in a society where everything must be earned and we are encouraged to hoard for ourselves whatever success we can achieve, these principles look a lot like highway robbery.

But when you remember the presence of an omnipotent, all-loving and all-merciful God, it turns our gun-slinging sense of justice on its head. For how does justice inhabit the same universe as a God who is so quick to give and indeed to forgive?

Well, very easily, when we remember Who exactly is the source of every good and perfect thing in this world. There is no law that cannot be traced back to the Word. And the Word saves our souls.

Is that justice? No, that is a gift. It is the reckless, indulgent gift of a father whose love is greater than His anger. What is justice in the Biblical sense?

The answer is simple. Look at your life. See the hours in your day? See your spouse, your kids, your grandkids? See the house they live in, the money in your wallet, the food in your fridge, the breath in your lungs?

Calling it all your own, refusing to share any of it — that's robbery. Giving it all back to the One who gave it to you — that's justice.

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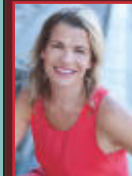
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
