STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION



Our readings offer us examples of how we should be living, and they present us with an opportunity to make a radical change in our lives.

In our first reading, Joshua tells the leaders of the Israelites to decide as to who they shall serve in

this life. As he presents them with this choice, he boldly states, "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord." Who or what does your household serve? Whether you are a household of one or twelve, now is the time to decide, 'will we serve the Lord?'

We are constantly bombarded with endless distractions around us. It can be very easy to serve other 'gods' in our lives. For instance, putting technology (phone, internet, TV), kids' extracurricular activities, our jobs, or our social lives before the Lord. We also might be putting these things above our loved ones, and if we are doing that, then we are putting them above our relationship with God.

With this in mind, we must strive each day to intentionally live as disciples of Christ. It starts with commitment — incorporating personal daily prayer and increasing that prayer week by week, incorporating prayer into our marriages and families, frequenting the sacraments, and serving others. Through this time with the Lord and service to those around us, He will reveal to us where to go next.



Reflect on how you may not be putting God first in your life and decide to respond like the Israelites, "Far be it from us to forsake the Lord for the service of other gods... Therefore we also will serve the Lord, for he is our God."

Minimum requirement is the ability to read music. Prior singing and choral experience is helpful but not required.

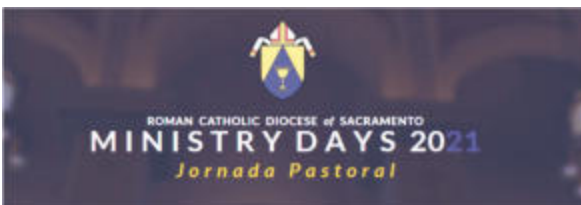

Testimony of Stewardship El Testimonio de Corresponsabilidad

Parents, for instance, have work of great importance to do in the domestic church, the home. Within the family, they must teach their children the truths of the faith and pray with them; share Christian values with them in the face of pressures to conform to the hostile values of a secularized society; and initiate them into the practice of stewardship itself, in all its dimensions, contrary to today's widespread consumerism and individualism. This may require adjusting the family's own patterns of consumption and its lifestyle, including the use of television and other media which sometimes preach values in conflict with the mind of Christ. Above all, it requires that parents themselves be models of stewardship, especially by their selfless service to one another, to their children, and to church and community needs.

Los padres de familia, por ejemplo, tienen un trabajo muy importante que realizar en la iglesia doméstica, el hogar. Dentro de la familia, deben enseñar a sus hijos las verdades de la fe y orar con ellos; compartir con ellos los valores cristianos ante las presiones de actuar según los valores hostiles de una sociedad secularizada; e iniciarlos en la práctica de la corresponsabilidad en todas sus dimensiones, para contrarrestar el individualismo y el consumismo ampliamente difundidos. Esto requerirá probablemente que se ajusten los patrones familiares de consumo y estilo de vida, incluyendo el uso de la televisión y otros medios que a veces predicán valores que están en conflicto con el pensamiento de Cristo. Por encima de todo, requerirá que los padres sean a su vez modelos de corresponsabilidad, especialmente en su entrega generosa del uno al otro, a sus hijos, y a las necesidades de su iglesia y su comunidad.

Summer of Faith: The Creed—Week 7

The Four Marks of the Church and Communion of Saints

When we recite the Nicene Creed at Mass, we profess “... One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.” We know by the Church’s four marks — the Church is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic — that the Catholic Church is the Church that Jesus Christ founded. Jesus gives these traits to the Church through the Holy Spirit. Let’s look at each one:

- ◆ **The Church is One:** The Holy Spirit unifies all believers with each other in Christ. This mysterious unity is “the essence of the Church” (CCC 813). This mark also refers to the unity of the Church’s belief, worship and liturgy, and government.
- ◆ **The Church is Holy:** because her founder, Jesus Christ is holy and because the Church exists to bring all people to salvation in Jesus Christ through the Sacraments.
- ◆ **The Church is Catholic:** The word catholic here means universal, in the sense of being whole and complete.
- ◆ **The Church is Apostolic:** today through their successors, the bishops. Jesus made the Apostles the first bishops at the Last Supper, giving them a share of His sacred power to celebrate Mass and minister the Sacraments for all Christians. The Apostles then passed on these sacred powers and traditions to proven men through the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried, He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God, the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. Verano de Fe: el credo - Semana 7

Las Cuatro Marcas de la Iglesia y la Comunión de los Santos

Cuando recitamos el Credo Niceno en la Misa, profesamos una Iglesia “... Una, Santa, Católica y Apostólica”. Sabemos por las cuatro marcas de la Iglesia - la Iglesia es una, santa, católica y apostólica - que la Iglesia Católica es la Iglesia que fundó Jesucristo. Jesús le da estos rasgos a la Iglesia a través del Espíritu Santo. Veamos cada uno:

- ◆ **La Iglesia es Una:** El Espíritu Santo unifica a todos los creyentes entre sí en Cristo. Esta unidad misteriosa es “la esencia de la Iglesia” (CIC 813). Esta marca también se refiere a la unidad de las creencias, el culto, la liturgia y el gobierno de la Iglesia.
- ◆ **La Iglesia es santa:** porque su fundador, Jesucristo es santo y porque la Iglesia existe para llevar a todas las personas a la salvación en Jesucristo a través de los sacramentos.
- ◆ **La Iglesia es Católica:** La palabra católica aquí significa universal, en el sentido de ser íntegro y completo.
- ◆ **La Iglesia es apostólica:** hoy a través de sus sucesores, los obispos. Jesús hizo de los Apóstoles los primeros obispos en la Última Cena, dándoles una parte de Su poder sagrado para celebrar la Misa y ministrar los sacramentos para todos los cristianos. Los Apóstoles luego transmitieron estos poderes y tradiciones sagrados a hombres probados a través del Sacramento del Orden Sagrado.

Submission as Stewardship.

We aren't comfortable with the idea of submission. Our society champions equality, and rightly so — but it's a mistake to think that submission is at odds with equality. To submit ourselves fully, we must first be free. We must first be our own masters. God has us that freedom with the salvation He offers. We are no longer the slaves of sin. Now He asks us to be subordinate to one another, in the name of Christ.

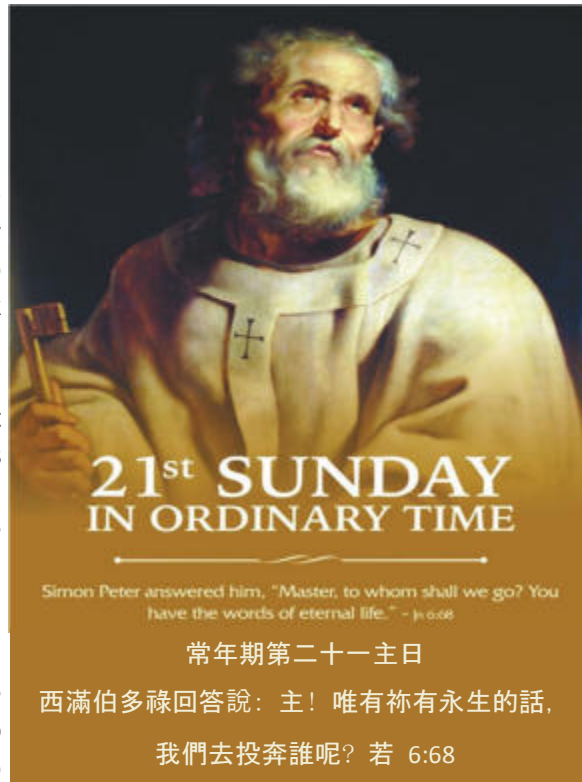
What a completely uncomfortable task! What He's asking is for us to be subordinate to the person who irritates us the most. The person we really can't stand. The person who doesn't respect us or appreciate what we have to offer. The person we think we're smarter than, more talented than. The person we envy.

That's the real challenge of stewardship, isn't it? Subordination myself by giving of time, of money, of relationship. Putting the needs or wants of another above my own when they haven't done anything special to earn it.

I invite you to consider the cross — the most radical expression of submission, and of stewardship, that ever existed. If there was ever someone who deserved superiority, isn't it the God who let Himself be nailed to a tree, who gave so freely of His life, His body, His blood, His everything?

To look at him in his agony is to truly understand the beauty of submission — of laying down what you have for the good of the other.

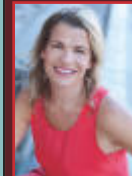
