

A Glimpse of Spirituality 灵修一瞥143 (Matt 瑪14:13-21)

Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

一個黑色幽默：耶穌在曠野治療病人之後，擔心人們回家會餓著肚子。懷著慈悲心，耶穌要行奇蹟來餵飽飢餓的人。然而，他需要人的委身與合作，因為天國是互相分享生命的地方。他問：“你們有食物給我行奇蹟？”其中有窮人也有富人。窮人給了耶穌五餅二魚，說：“這是我們所有的。”當耶穌問富人能貢獻什麼，他們氣定神閒回答：“我們剛吃完晚餐。”這個奇蹟對我們意味著什麼？奇蹟所表達的信念：通過耶穌，我們可以分享天主的豐盛生命；它也顯示耶穌賦予門徒力量，讓他們繼續他的慈悲工作。耶穌接過五餅二魚，為眾人樹立榜樣，即天主真的關心所有人的需要，無論是物質或精神。耶穌所行奇蹟彰顯天主真相：慈悲大愛與關懷。

耶穌分享五餅二魚時有四個動作：拿起、祝福、擘開和遞給：“拿起那五個餅和兩條魚，望天祝福了；把餅擘開，遞給門徒，門徒再分給群眾。”第一個動作“拿起” (labōn) 表示耶穌預備施行奇蹟，彰顯自己掌握生死權柄。第二個行動“祝福” (eulogēsen) 表示他準備用豐富的餅和魚餵飽人群，以像徵他的豐盛恩寵。第三個動作“擘開” (klasas) 目的指向與飢餓的人群分享。最後，耶穌將祝福過的餅和魚“遞給” (edōken) 門徒，讓他們去接觸人們。值得注意的，是門徒跟隨耶穌方式，通過給予跟人們分享這奇蹟食糧，這是對所有基督徒慈悲心的培育。

十字架上，耶穌的身體為了人的永生而被擘開。這是最豐盛的恩寵，沒有任何人與事物可以比擬。

Focus of the Gospel:


The first reading and the Gospel next week focus on the choice to be made between God and riches. In the first reading, WISDOM is desired above all riches. Wisdom in the scriptures does equate to "knowledge" but is a personification of God, an image of God. In other words, GOD is more desirable than all riches. In the Gospel, Jesus challenges a man to "...sell everything you have—then come follow me." We hear that the man rejected the invitation because ...he had many possessions. On the surface, the scriptures seem to point to riches being an obstacle to a deep relationship with God. But the meaning is deeper; it is a call to put aside anything that keeps us from wholeheartedly following Jesus.

- ◆ Imagine Jesus asking you to give up the thing most important to you and follow. Would you be able to?
- ◆ How can you put Jesus first in your life?
- ◆ Pray Psalm 90:12-17 together.

Reading 1 Gn 2:18-24

The LORD God said: "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a suitable partner for him." So the LORD God formed out of the ground various wild animals and various birds of the air, and he brought them to the man to see what he would call them; whatever the man called each of them would be its name. The man gave names to all the cattle, all the birds of the air, and all wild animals; but none proved to be the suitable partner for the man.

So the LORD God cast a deep sleep on the man, and while he was asleep, he took out one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh. The LORD God then built up into a woman the rib that he had taken from the man. W

hen he brought her to the man, the man said: "This one, at last, is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; this one shall be called 'woman,' for out of 'her man' this one has been taken." That is why a man leaves his father and mother and clings to his wife, and the two of them become one flesh.

The Pharisees approached Jesus and asked, "Is it lawful for a husband to divorce his wife?" They were testing him. He said to them in reply, "What did Moses command you?" They replied, "Moses permitted a husband to write a bill of divorce and dismiss her." But Jesus told them, "Because of the hardness of your hearts he wrote you this commandment. But from the beginning of creation, God made them male and female. For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. So they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, no human being must separate." In the house the disciples again questioned Jesus about this. He said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her; and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery."

And people were bringing children to him that he might touch them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this he became indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not prevent them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Amen, I say to you, whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it." Then he embraced them and blessed them, placing his hands on them.


