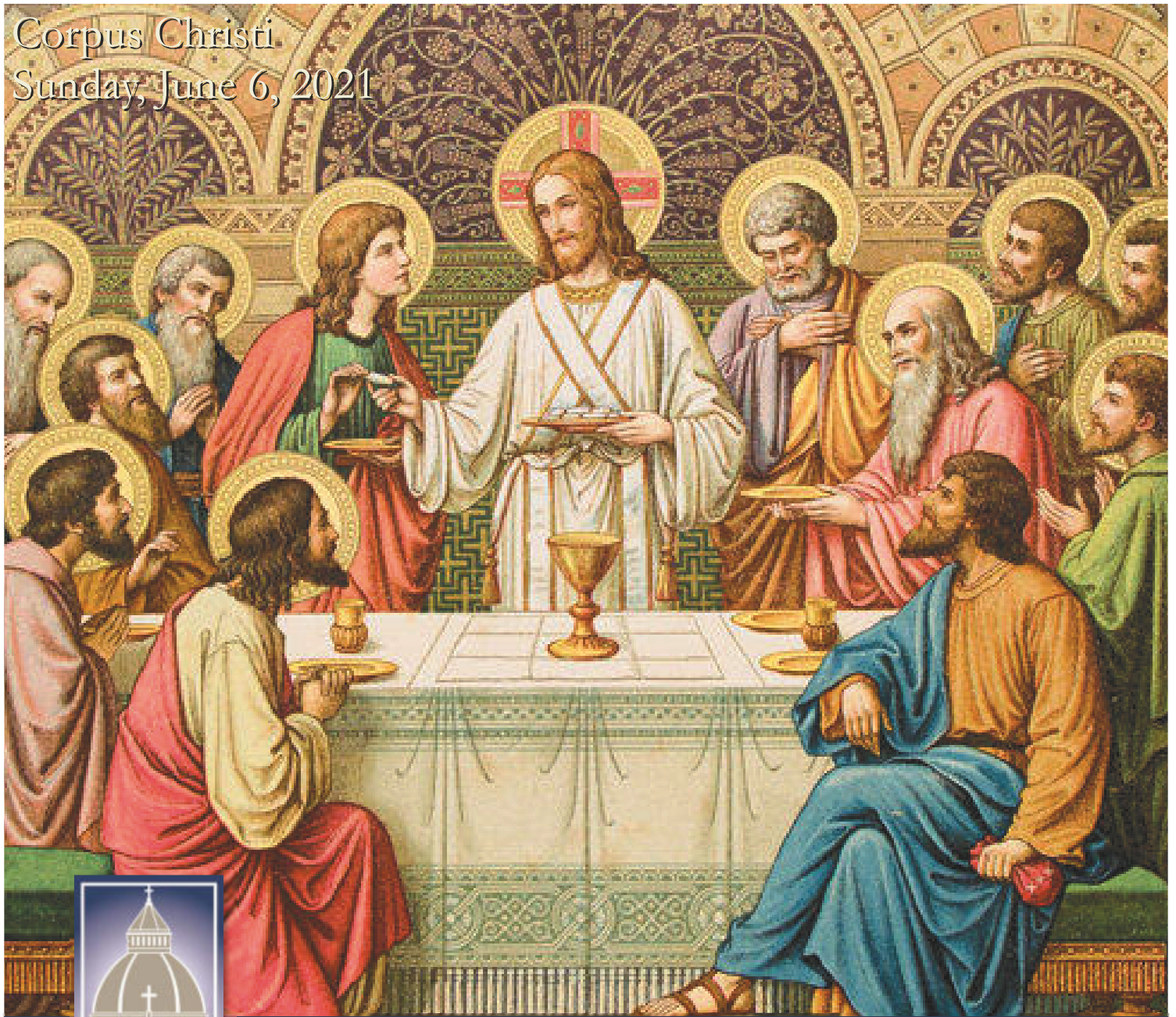

## O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine!

This week...


This weekend celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ, a feast traditionally called “Corpus Christi” (the Body of Christ). “The Solemnity of Corpus Christi forces us to take a deep look at our belief in the Eucharist as well as our participation in the Eucharistic Community that is the Church. The solemnity reminds us: This is Jesus. He is present on our altars offering Himself up for us to the Father. He is present within us in the reception of communion. He is present at Eucharistic Adoration looking at us as we look at Him. Perhaps a good reminder for us all of what a Catholic Church is would come if we return to the fundamentals: genuflecting (or bowing if our bodies won’t allow) when we enter the pew, and kneeling to speak to the Presence of the Lord before us. We should also genuflect or at least bow any time that we cross in front of the tabernacle.

So what am I doing here? I asked myself that question at Eucharistic Adoration. Ask yourselves: What am I doing here when I come to Mass, when I receive communion, when I go to Eucharistic Adoration. What are we doing? The Solemnity of Corpus Christi tells us what we are doing. We are experiencing the Presence of Jesus Christ in the Great Gift of the Eucharist.” (Msgr. Joseph Pelegrino)

Este fin de semana celebra el Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, una fiesta tradicionalmente llamada “Corpus Christi” (el Cuerpo de Cristo). “La solemnidad del Corpus Christi nos obliga a profundizar en nuestra fe en la Eucaristía, así como en nuestra participación en la Comunidad Eucarística que es la Iglesia. La solemnidad nos recuerda: este es Jesús. Él está presente en nuestros altares ofreciéndose por nosotros al Padre. Está presente en nosotros en la recepción de la comunión. Él está presente en la Adoración Eucarística mirándonos como nosotros lo miramos. Quizás un buen recordatorio para todos nosotros de lo que es una Iglesia Católica vendría si volvemos a los fundamentos: hacer una genuflexión (o inclinarnos si nuestro cuerpo no lo permite) cuando entramos en el banco y arrodillarnos para hablar con la Presencia del Señor. antes que nosotros. También debemos hacer una genuflexión o al menos inclinarnos cada vez que crucemos frente al tabernáculo.


Entonces, ¿qué estoy haciendo aquí? Me hice esa pregunta en la Adoración Eucarística. Pregúntense: ¿Qué hago aquí cuando vengo a Misa, cuando recibo la comunión, cuando voy a la Adoración Eucarística? ¿Que estamos haciendo? La solemnidad de Corpus Christi nos dice lo que estamos haciendo. Estamos experimentando la Presencia de Jesucristo en el Gran Don de la Eucaristía”. (Mons. Joseph Pelegrino)

## Formación en la Fe *En el año que viene*

Este año, pasamos de lecciones individuales basadas en grados a un hermoso aprendizaje de la fe basado en la familia llamado “Una Familia de Fe”. Al principio lo hicimos para simplificar nuestro proceso de aprendizaje para que a los padres les resulte sencillo mantener a sus hijos comprometidos con su fe durante la pandemia, pero lo encontramos tan rico como una forma de permitir que nuestras familias crezcan juntas, que deseamos Continuar ofreciendo esto como el modelo principal de construir la fe para todas nuestras familias.

Antes de que su familia se registre para el próximo año, le pedimos que considere algunas cosas:

- **¿Está mi hijo listo para recibir los sacramentos?** ¿Cómo podemos prepararlos mejor para apreciar la vida espiritual de oración y sacramento? (es decir, ¿nosotros como padres modelamos la vida católica prestando atención a nuestra propia vida espiritual de oración, servicio y sacramentos? ¿Llevamos a nuestros hijos a Misa y nos confesamos regularmente? ¿Oramos con ellos?)

## Faith Formation *In the Coming Year*

This year, we shifted from individual grade-based lessons to a beautiful family-based learning of faith called “A Family of Faith”. At first we did so to simplify our process of learning to make it simple for parents to keep their kids engaged in their faith during the pandemic, but we found it so rich as a way to allow our families to grow together, that we wish to continue to offer this as the primary model of building faith for all of our families.

Before your family registers for this coming year, we ask that you consider a few things:

- **When can your family come to the Cathedral together twice a month to be formed in faith?** (i.e. Saturday mornings or afternoons? Sunday before or after Mass? Weeknight?)
- **How can your family make your home the domestic church?** (i.e. when do we pray together, do we have signs of our faith around the home to remind us of God? Do we invite God to be not just a part of our daily lives, but the center?)
- **Is my child ready to receive the Sacraments?** How can we better prepare them to appreciate the Spiritual Life of prayer and Sacrament? (i.e. do we as parents model the Catholic life by attending to our own spiritual life of prayer, service, and Sacraments? Do we take our children to Mass and confession regularly? Pray with them?)

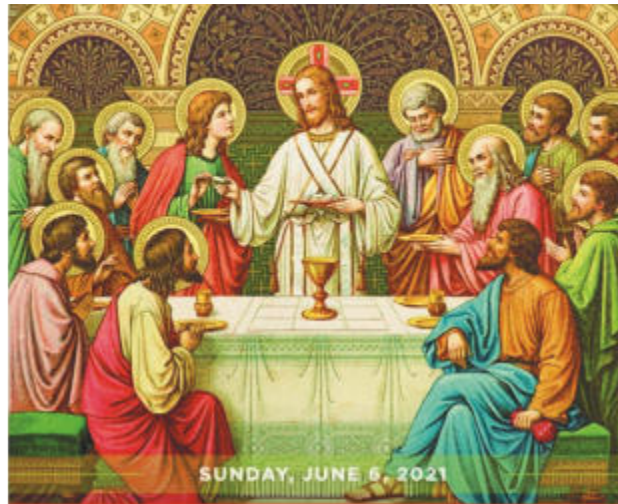
## We Can Prepare the Upper Room

We all know that person, don't we? Hey, maybe we've even been that person. "I have a great relationship with God, but I don't go to church regularly. God and I are on good terms. I can talk to Him just fine on my own."

There isn't anything false in these statements. It's important to have an intimate, even conversational prayer relationship with God. But the problem with this attitude is that it implies that churches don't matter. Community worship doesn't matter. Today, we are reminded exactly why that is so untrue. Why we need our parishes, our priests, and each other. The Body and Blood of Christ — that's what it's all about. If it's not about that, it's not about anything. If we don't have the Eucharist, we're just like the ancient priests, making sacrifices that don't have the power to redeem anybody.

Where do we receive the Body and Blood of Christ? For most of us, it's in our parishes. The altar of sacrifice is also the table we gather in front of, as a family, to become one with Christ in the truest and realest way possible, recreating the scene in the Upper Room over and over again every time Mass is celebrated. The disciples were commissioned by Christ to prepare the Upper Room for the Last Supper. How can we take up that work ourselves? How can we strengthen the bonds in our spiritual family? How can we serve our parish, always remembering that the table is not meant to be set only for two?

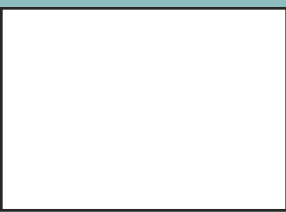

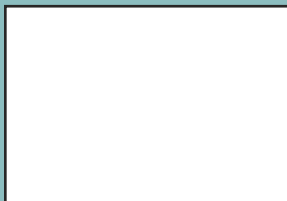

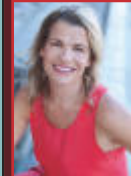
