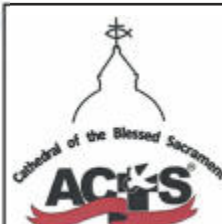

There's still time to bring your Commitment Card to Mass or fill out Online.

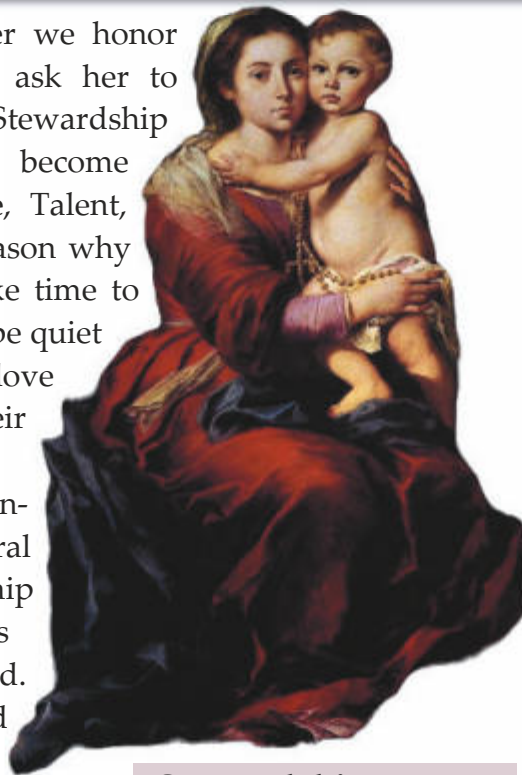
Our Lady of the Rosary

Fundamentos de la Biblia HOJA DE TRABAJO DE LAS ESCRITURAS Bible Basics: Scripture Worksheet



Saint Jerome said, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." That is one reason we are beginning our year of faith together in a review of Bible Basics. We know that the Bible is divided into two main parts: The Old Testament and the New Testament. The Old Testament begins with the book of Genesis and its introductory sentence may be familiar to you: "In the beginning, ..." The Old Testament tells the story of how God created the world, Adam and Eve's fall from grace, and how God entered into covenants with His Chosen People, the Israelites. The New Testament tells the story of our Savior, Jesus Christ, and the New Covenant in His Blood. God loved the world so much that He sent His Son, Jesus Christ (ref. John 3:16), to die for our sins and open Heaven to us. Our First Activity explores some basic Bible principles, to distinguish Old and New Testament stories.

San Jerónimo dijo: "La ignorancia de la Escritura es la ignorancia de Cristo". Esa es una de las razones por las que estamos comenzando nuestro año de fe juntos en una revisión de los conceptos básicos de la Biblia. Sabemos que la Biblia se divide en dos partes principales: el Antiguo Testamento y el Nuevo Testamento. El Antiguo Testamento comienza con el libro de Génesis y su frase introductoria puede resultarle familiar: "En el principio, ..." El Antiguo Testamento cuenta la historia de cómo Dios creó el mundo, la caída de la gracia de Adán y Eva, y cómo entró Dios en pactos con su pueblo escogido, los israelitas. El Nuevo Testamento cuenta la historia de nuestro Salvador Jesucristo y el Nuevo Pacto en Su Sangre. Dios amó tanto al mundo que envió a su Hijo, Jesucristo (ref. Juan 3:16), para morir por nuestros pecados y abrirnos el cielo. Nuestra primera actividad explora algunos principios bíblicos básicos para distinguir las historias del Antiguo y del Nuevo Testamento.

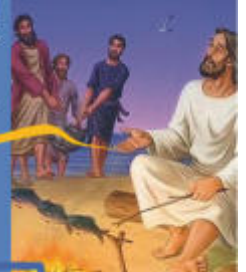

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS - Therein lies the...rib

"If I were God..." is a dangerous way to start a sentence, but how many of us do this? Probably more regularly than we would like to admit. Even if we don't verbalize the sentiment, we likely think it from time to time. Most of us finish that statement with some genius, original idea for eradicating difficulty and pain from the world. If I were God, I wouldn't let anyone go hungry. If I were God, all wealth would be equally distributed. If I were God, war wouldn't exist.

I imagine that, when we think thoughts like these, God shakes His head and wonders

why we don't look a little harder at the whole of His creation — because I can promise you, it's never lacking.

When Adam had a need for a companion, God used what was available: Adam's rib. Everything that He had put into place was already perfect, already complete. Woman was a new creation, but not a new species. Adam searched through all of creation to find the perfect mate, but God had tucked the answer inside of His creation all along.

I'm guilty of it as much as anyone else — looking to Heaven with a chip on my shoulder. "Why haven't you sent me what I need? I've been asking over and over again." But have I even thought to look inside of myself?

Where is the rib you are missing today? What are the opportunities God has set before you? What are the needs that He is ready to fulfill, if only you would stop wasting time lamenting all the solutions that don't fit the bill?

“如果我是天主...”用這樣的句子來做開頭是危險的方式，我們當中有多少會這樣做呢？可能比一般我們願承認的還來得多。即使我們不用情緒表達出來，也可能會時不時的想一想，我們大多數人都會以某種天才或原創的想法，來消除世界困難和痛苦，來結束這論述，如果我是天主，我將不使任何人飽受飢餓，如果我是天主，所有的財富都會平均分配，如果我是天主，世界不會存在著戰爭。

我想像著，當我們有這樣的想法時，上主應當會搖首感嘆，為什麼我們不再努力一點，看看祂所有的創造物- 因為我向你們保證，

甚麼都不曾缺乏。

當亞當需要一位相稱的助手時，上主以可用之物來造就，那就是亞當的肋骨。祂所安排的一切已經完美，完成了。女人是新造的，但不是新物種，亞當搜尋所有受造物中理想的伴侶，但上主一直將答案藏在祂的受造物中。

我和其他的人一樣對此感到愧疚-我帶著肩膀中的芯片仰望天空，"為何祂還沒給我所需要的？我一遍又一遍的問。"但是我有沒有想過要檢視自己的內心？

今天你所欠缺的肋骨在哪裡？天主賜予你面前的是甚麼樣的機會？祂已經準備好要滿足你的是甚麼？只要你停止浪費時間，在尋求不適合的解決方案而哀嘆。

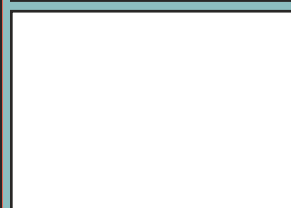
