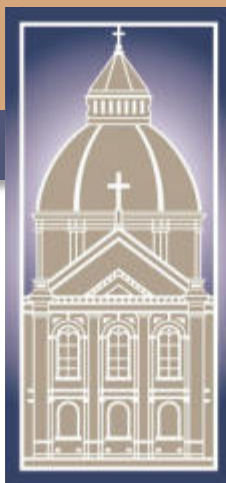

Queridos Amigos en Cristo:

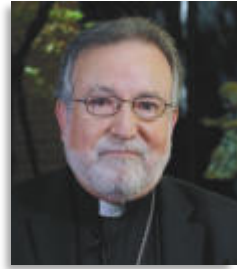

The Catholic community in the Diocese of Sacramento will be able to celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi, around the sacred altars of their parish churches on Sunday, June 14th. I am lifting the heartbreaking suspension of public celebrations of the Sacrifice of the Mass starting on Monday, June 8th. This will help pastors ready the churches for the glorious Feast of Corpus Christi. Parishes that are prepared to implement all the necessary public health protocols may begin offering Mass with the Faithful on June 8th. This Pentecost Sunday, we continued to gather behind the closed doors as did the first disciples. The Blessed Mother Mary was in their company as they prayed. She will certainly be with each of you and your families. Pray with her as she intercedes for all of us. Her example teaches us to be open to the Spirit's promptings even in these uncertain days. The Holy Spirit will help us to welcome the Lord Jesus with open hands and hearts as the Feast of Corpus Christi draws closer.

Upon arrival CHECK-IN

- **Come with a Mask.** We ask that all wear a mask if above two years old. Please apply your mask before getting to the Church. You may want to wear gloves.
- **Arrive Early.** There will be a check-in point at the main doors of the Cathedral. All that enter must provide their contact information so you can be notified in event of an outbreak of the virus traced to the time of your visit. This information will not be shared or sold.
- **Be Flexible. Be Patient.** Our volunteers will do their best to be welcoming as they show you to your seat. We know many of us have our favorite spots; you may need to 'give it up' during this time. Let them seat you and use the experience as a prayer for the end of the virus.

Receiving COMMUNION

- **Remain where you are.** At the time of Communion, stay in your place. The priest or minister of the sacrament will come to you. Please stand when to receive.
- **Receive in the Hand if you can.** The Church asks that you receive in the hand to lessen the potential contact. If your personal devotion demands you receive on the tongue, you may. You may also receive a blessing by standing with arms crossed.

We look forward to be able to celebrate together! United in prayer!

The PASTOR'S Corner

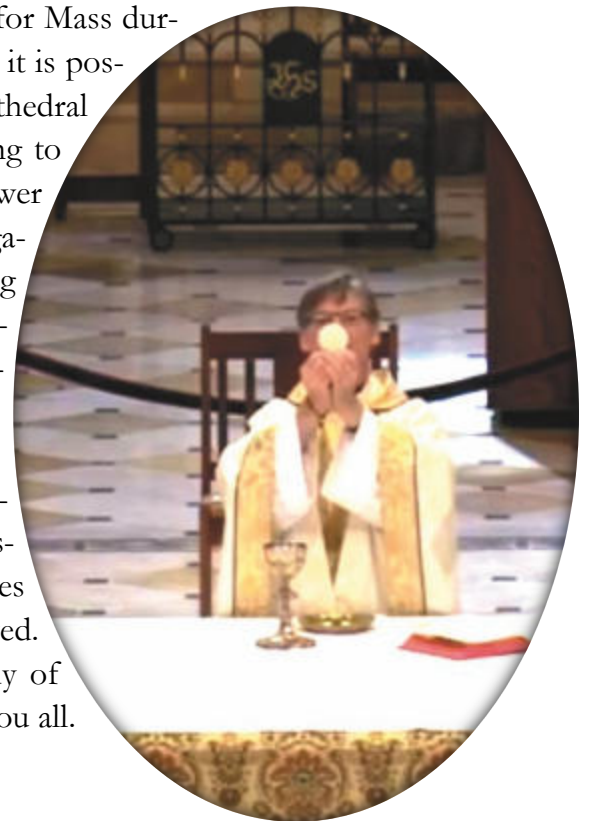

During our "sheltering in place," we were challenged as individuals to re-examine our faith and seek greater union with the Lord, but the ability to worship together as one Body is truly a great gift and necessary reality of the Church. I pray for each of us that we always appreciate the beauty of the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, in our lives

I welcome all of you back to the Table of the Eucharist here at the Cathedral. As we resume, I realize our gathering will be limited and incomplete. I am aware that some will be hesitant to return to public worship. This is understandable and strongly encouraged for those who are more susceptible to the painful results of this virus. No one should feel obligated to be present for Mass during this time. Live-streaming of the Mass will continue. As well, it is possible that maintaining a maximum of 100 attendees at the Cathedral per Mass might not provide enough seating for everyone wanting to worship. Even though we will have over-flow seating in the lower level, that too might fill up. This could lead to frustration and negative attitudes. We will do our best to provide for everyone during a difficult time, so please be prayerful and patient. We might anticipate a few bumps in the road, but I encourage all of us to focus on the beauty of the Divine Presence.

I know everyone is excited about returning to the source and summit of our spiritual pilgrimage. I ask that we pray for great wisdom and patience during these upcoming weeks. The challenges that lie ahead will be greatly diminished by the blessings received. We give thanks to the Father for the gift of His Son, The Body of Christ and for calling us to be His Body in the world. God bless you all.

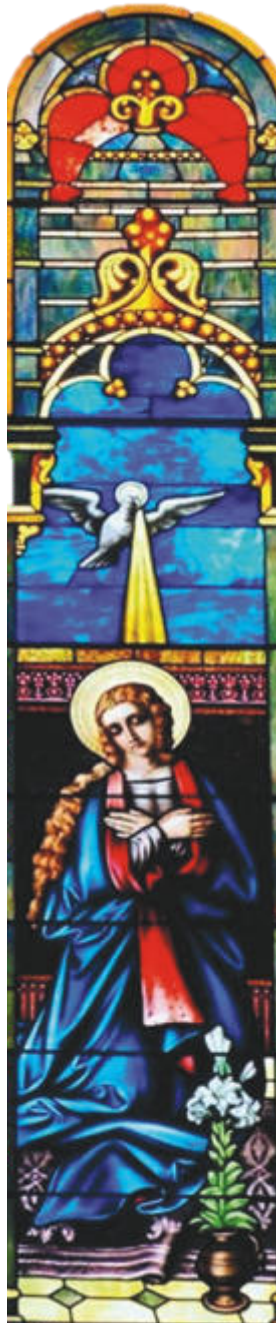

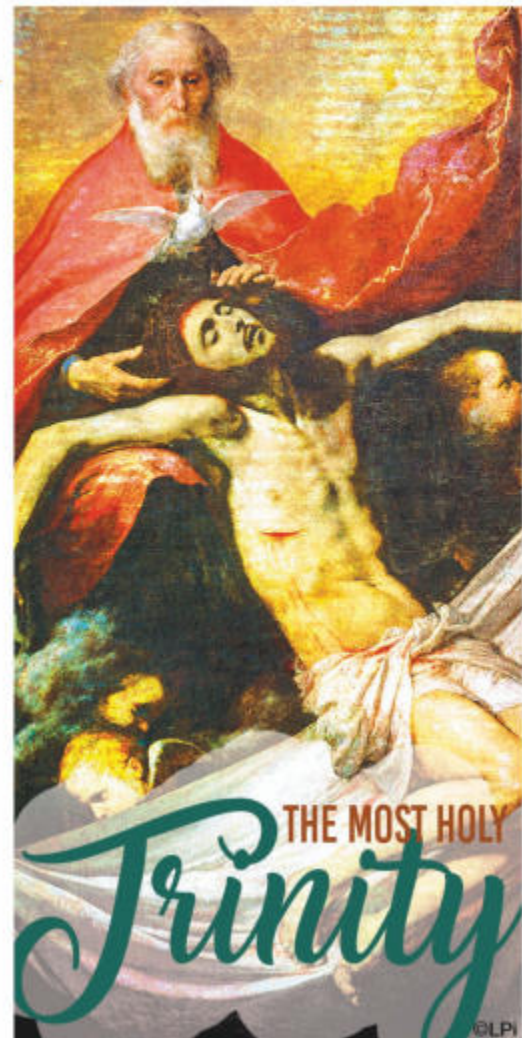

Dear Brothers and Sisters, Good morning!

God's plan for humanity is good, but in our daily affairs we experience the presence of evil. It is a daily experience. Adam and Eve (cf. Gen 3:1-7) doubt God's good intentions; they think they are dealing with an envious God who impedes their happiness. This is where their rebellion comes from: they no longer believe in a generous Creator who desires their happiness.

Evil becomes even more disruptive with the second human generation, it is stronger: it is the story of Cain and Abel (cf. Gen 4:1-16). Cain is envious of his brother; there is the seed of envy; even though he is the first born, he sees Abel as a rival, one who undermines his primacy....And thus the story of the first brotherhood ends in murder. I think of human fraternity today... war everywhere.

While reading these narratives, one has the impression that prayer is a bulwark; it is man's refuge before the flood wave of evil that grows in the world. On closer inspection, we also pray to be saved from ourselves. It is important to pray: "Lord, please, save me from myself, from my ambitions, from my passions". The prayerful of the first pages of the Bible are peace workers: indeed, when prayer is authentic, it frees one from the instincts of violence and it is a gaze directed to God, that he may return to take care of the heart of mankind. We read in the Catechism: "This kind of prayer is lived by many righteous people in all religions" (ccc, 2569).



#PopeQuote

I remember the story of one man—an atheist—with no religious feeling in his heart, but as a child he heard his grandmother pray, and this remained in his heart. And at a very difficult time in his life, that memory returned to his heart and said: "But my grandmother used to pray...". He thus began to pray with his grandmother's formulas, and there he found Jesus. Prayer is always a chain of life: many men and women who pray sow life. **Prayer sows life, small prayers: this is why it is so important to teach children to pray.** I suffer when I encounter children who do not know how to make the sign of the Cross. They have to be taught to make the sign of the Cross properly, because it is the first prayer. Then perhaps they may forget, take another path, but the first prayers learned as a child remain in the heart, because they are a seed of life, the seed of dialogue with God. The journey of God in the history of God is conveyed through them: it has passed through a "remainder" of humanity that has not conformed to the law of the fittest, but has asked God to perform his miracles, and above all to transform our hearts of stone into hearts of flesh (cf. Ez 36:26). And this helps prayer: because prayer opens the door to God, turning our often stony hearts into a human heart. And this demands a lot of humanity, and with humanity one can pray well.

回顧 2018年教宗三鐘經：天主聖三節慶祝天主是愛

這是默觀和讚美耶穌基督天主之奧祕的節日，祂是聖父，聖子和聖神這三個位格在共融中的一體。在這個節日，我們以常新的驚喜慶祝天主是愛，祂無償地將祂的生命獻給我們，並要求我們在全世界傳播這生命。教宗方濟各在聖伯多祿廣場三鐘經祈禱活動中指出，主日讀經“讓我們明白了”天主對我們的愛，以及祂願意揭示給我們的訊息。教宗說：這就是“天主與我們同在”，祂在我們身邊，祂與我們同行，關注我們的個人歷史，照顧我們每個人，尤其是最弱小和最需要幫助的人。祂是“在天的天主”，並且祂也“臨在地上”。所以，我們不相信一個遙遠的實體，一個冷漠的實體！相反地，我們相信創造宇宙，誕生一個民族，降生成人，為我們死而復活的愛；這愛如同聖神，更新一切，使之達到圓滿。教宗引用聖保祿的例子，指出天主對我們每個人的溫柔與愛。教宗說：聖保祿親自經歷了由‘天主是愛’所施展的轉變，他告訴我們天主渴望被稱為父親，甚至是‘爸爸’。天主是‘我們的爸爸’。我們要以小孩般完全的信賴投入那給予我們生命的那一位的懷抱。聖神在我們內施展作為，使耶穌基督不被簡化為過去的人物，而是讓我們覺得祂很親近，祂是我們同時代的人，我們能體驗到做為被天主所愛的子女的喜悅。教宗最後提醒我們每位基督徒的使命以及當天節日的意義，他說：正是藉著天主的臨在和祂聖神的力量，我們才能平穩地履行祂委託給我們的使命。甚麼使命呢？向每個人宣講和見證祂的福音，從而擴大與祂的共融，以及源自這共融的喜悅。天主與我們同行，祂使我們充滿喜悅，而喜悅幾乎是基督徒的第一語言。因此，天主聖三節使我們醒思天主的奧祕。祂用愛且為了愛而總是創造，贖回和聖化，讓接納祂的一切受造物映射出祂美麗，良善和真理的光環。

Review - Pope at Angelus: Celebrate the God of Love on the feast of the Most Holy Trinity

Speaking to the faithful in St. Peter's square for the Angelus Prayer, Pope Francis remarked on the Feast we celebrate on the Sunday after Pentecost saying it calls us to spread God's love throughout the world. He said that the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity highlights the mystery of God, Jesus Christ, who is One in the communion of three Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Remarking on the liturgical Readings of the day help, the Pope said "they help us to understand that rather than wanting to reveal to us that He exists, God wants us to know that He is "with us", He is interested in our personal history and takes care of each of us, starting from the smallest and the most needy. "He is God up there in heaven, but also down here on earth" he said. Underscoring the closeness of "the God of Love who created the universe and generated a people, became flesh, died and rose for us" he said the Holy Spirit transforms all and leads to fullness. The Pope reflected on the reading of St. Paul whom, he said, "personally experienced this transformation brought about by the God of Love." He said Paul tells us of God's wish to be called Father - "Daddy" - with the absolute trust of a child who abandons himself into the arms of He who gave him life. The Pope said the Apostle also says that the Holy Spirit, acting in us, ensures that Jesus Christ is not reduced to a mere character of the past, but that we feel close to Him: "He is our contemporary and experiences the joy of being children who are loved by God". Finally, he said, in the Gospel, the Risen Lord promises to remain with us forever and it is precisely through his presence and the strength of his Spirit that we can carry out with serenity the mission that he entrusts to us: to proclaim and witness his Gospel to all, to spread our communion with Him and the joy that derives from it. Pope Francis concluded his catechesis urging the faithful to celebrate the Feast of Most Holy Trinity which invites leads us to contemplate the mystery of a God who ceaselessly creates, redeems and sanctifies, always with love and out of love.
