FAITH IN FOCUS: TODAY'S FEAST

Today's feast celebrates Mary's Assumption into heaven. It is one of three feasts of Mary that are Holy Days of Obligation for Catholics in the United States. January 1 is the feast of Mary, the Mother of God, and December 8 is the feast of the Immaculate Conception of Mary. The assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into heaven has long been held as an important Catholic belief. The belief was not defined as dogma, however, until 1950 by Pope Pius XII. The dogma teaches that Mary, who was without sin, was taken, body and soul, into the glory of heaven.

The Gospel for this holy day recalls Mary's actions after the announcement of Jesus' birth by the Angel Gabriel. Mary goes to visit her cousin Elizabeth who is also with child. Elizabeth greets Mary with full recognition of the roles they and their unborn children will play in God's plan for salvation. Mary responds to Elizabeth's greeting with her song of praise, the Magnificat. Both women recall and echo God's history of showing favor upon the people of Israel. Mary's Magnificat, in particular, echoes the song of praise offered by Hannah, the mother of Samuel.

The Gospel for this day reminds us that Mary's Assumption into heaven is best understood with regard for the full spectrum of Catholic beliefs about the person of Christ and the person of Mary. Only Mary, who was born without stain of original sin—the Immaculate Conception—could give birth to Christ, who is fully God and fully human. This is called the Immaculate Conception. Because of Mary's role in God's plan of salvation, she does not suffer from the effects of sin, which are death and decay. Mary is the first to receive the fullness of the redemption that her son has won for all of humanity. The Church, therefore, recognizes Mary as the sign of the salvation promised to all.

Today's Gospel highlights Mary's faith. Mary's faith enabled her to recognize the work of God in her people's history and in her own life. Her openness to God allowed God to work through her so that salvation might come to all. Mary is a model and symbol of the Church. May we be like Mary, open and cooperative in God's plan of salvation.

PASTOR'S CORNER

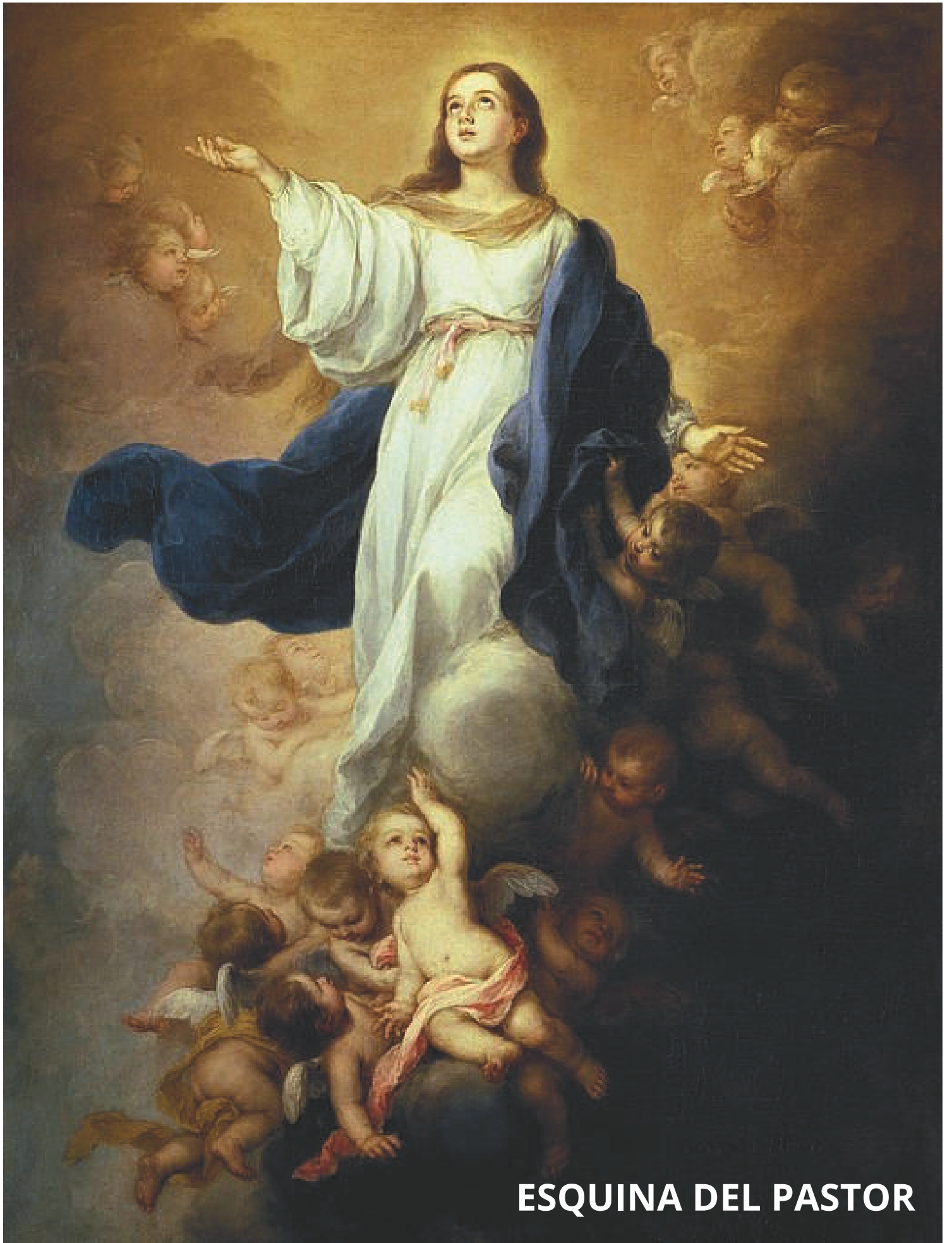

Summer of Faith: The Creed—

Who is the Holy Spirit? As we learned in October, the Holy Spirit is the Third Divine Person of the Trinity. From the beginning of Creation, the Spirit has been at work with the Father and the Son. We can see Him in the Old Testament, although He is hidden from our full understanding; the Spirit of God moved over the waters of creation; the Father breathed the Spirit of God into man and thus gave him life; the Holy Spirit spoke through the prophets in the Old Testament. The Holy Spirit is more fully revealed in the New Testament. The Holy Spirit preserved the Blessed Virgin Mary from all sin and conceived Jesus in Mary's womb. Throughout His life Jesus spoke of the Holy Spirit as a Life Giver or as a Counselor. The Risen Jesus breathed the Holy Spirit onto the Apostles as He gave them the power to forgive sin (John 20:21-23). He told the Apostles He would send the Holy Spirit to give them the fortitude they would need to spread the Gospel: "But you will receive power when the holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8). Jesus' promise of an outpouring of the Holy Spirit was fulfilled ten days later on the Feast of Pentecost. While they were hiding in the Upper Room, the Holy Spirit was poured out on Mary and the Apostles. They were given the spiritual help boldly to proclaim Jesus as Lord. Christ's Kingdom was open to all who believed in Him, and thousands of people were baptized on that day alone.

APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried, He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God, the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church ...

¿Quién es el Espíritu Santo? Como aprendimos en octubre, el Espíritu Santo es la Tercera Divina Persona de la Trinidad. Desde el principio de la creación, el Espíritu ha estado obrando con el Padre y con el Hijo. Podemos verlo en el Antiguo Testamento, aunque permanece oculto de nuestro pleno entendimiento: El Espíritu de Dios aleteaba sobre las aguas de la creación, el Padre soplo el Espíritu de Dios sobre el hombre y le dio vida, el Espíritu Santo habló por los profetas en el Antiguo Testamento. El Espíritu Santo se revela más plenamente en el Nuevo Testamento. El Espíritu Santo preservó a la Santísima Virgen María de todo pecado y concibió a Jesús en su vientre. Durante su vida, Jesús se refirió al Espíritu Santo como el dador de vida y el consolador. Jesús Resucitado soplo el Espíritu Santo sobre los Apóstoles y les dio poder para perdonar el pecado (Juan 20, 21- 23). Él le dijo a los Apóstoles que enviaría al Espíritu Santo para darles la fortaleza que necesitarían para propagar el Evangelio: "Pero recibirán la fuerza del Espíritu Santo cuando venga sobre ustedes, y serán mis testigos en Jerusalén, en toda Judea, en Samaria y hasta los extremos de la tierra" (Hechos 1, 8). La promesa de Jesús de una efusión del Espíritu Santo se llevó a plenitud diez días después, durante la fiesta de Pentecostés. Cuando estaban escondidos en el cenáculo, el Espíritu Santo se derramó sobre María y los Apóstoles. Ellos recibieron la ayuda espiritual que necesitaban para proclamar sin miedo a Jesús como el Señor. El Reino de Cristo estaba abierto para todos aquellos que creyeran en Él, y miles de personas fueron bautizadas ese día.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS - WWMD?

WWJD bracelets were all the rage about 25 years ago in Christian circles. I've always wondered if a WWMD bracelet might not make just as much sense, and maybe more. What Would Mary Do?

I would argue that Mary was the most exemplary steward who ever lived. Her answer was always "Yes." Yes, Lord, I am Your handmaiden. Yes, I will visit Elizabeth, and help her in the last difficult months of pregnancy. Yes, I will bring my son up in the Mosaic law and present him at the Temple of Jerusalem. Yes, I will give him to the crowds and to public ministry. Yes, I will offer him on this Cross, if it is Your will. Yes, yes, yes.

Well, I can't be like Mary, we think to ourselves. There's an intimidation factor with the Blessed Mother and Catholics sometimes — one that almost exceeds that of Christ. Perhaps it's because we are in awe of the fact that she was not divine in any way — she was a mere creation, like us — but somehow, she always had the courage to say yes. How could she do it, when we find it so hard?

Well, God certainly lavished on Mary extraordinary graces. Her lack of original sin liberated her to conform her will to God's. But God is impatient to give us, too, all the graces we need to be a steward in the example of Mary. He's waiting for us simply to ask. Just as in Adam we died, so in Christ — through Mary — we live.

What can we say yes to today, in Mary's example?

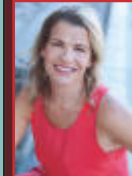
