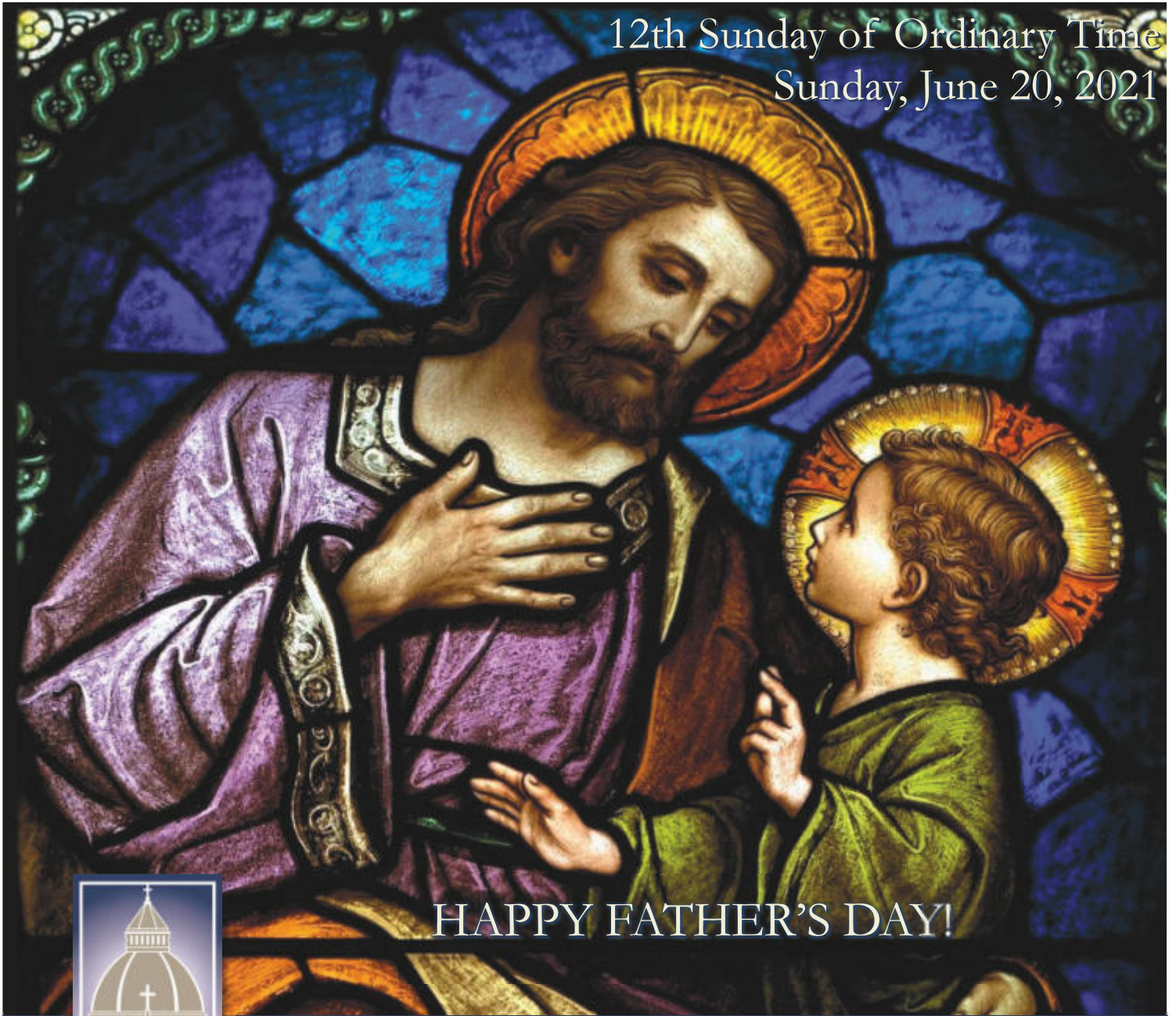

Pastors may accommodate the faithful for the celebration of the Sacrifice of the Mass as well as other sacramental and worship services at 100% of the seating capacity in the parish churches.

I am rescinding the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. **Starting Sunday, June 20, 2021 all the Catholic faithful in the Diocese of Sacramento are obliged to personally attend and actively participate in the Sunday celebration of the Sacrifice of the Mass** (Canon 1247). All the faithful are reminded of the

perennial obligation to keep holy the Lord's Day by observing Sunday with prayer, spiritual reflection, works of mercy, fellowship, and rest.

Pastors and the faithful should continue to observe sensible public health precautions:

- Practice frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer.
- Refrain from hand shaking and other forms of physical contact with others outside of one's household.
- Continue to clean the pews at least twice on Sundays and other days when there are multiple services.
- Facial masks are still encouraged.
- Priests, deacons, and extraordinary ministers should continue to use facial masks for the distribution of communion. During the distribution of communion priests, deacons, and extraordinary ministers should have sanitizer available for use when needed.



EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

- Waking God

A show of hands, ladies and gentlemen. Have any of you been given the silent treatment and had absolutely no idea why? Have any of you have sworn you're not going to demean yourself by explaining, for the thousandth time, that you need extra help with the kids before soccer practice, or that you feel ignored when your spouse doesn't ask how your day went? But sadly, love doesn't give you the ability to read minds. And in the end, we learn the lesson, again and again, we have to verbalize our feelings, our needs, our wants. Expecting your partner to anticipate your needs is guaranteed to end badly.

It's the same with God, even though, oddly enough, He does have the ability to read minds. But He still desires us to explain ourselves to Him, doesn't He? "I'm feeling scared of this." "I'm really worried about that." "God, I think I need x, y, and z. Help me. Please."

Jesus slept on that boat, as it was tossed and turned by the waves until his disciples woke him. "Why were you sleeping?" they ask. Well, geniuses, he was sleeping because they hadn't woken him up yet. They had wasted time cowering in fear, waiting for him to act. They gave him the silent treatment and they didn't even know it. God doesn't desire us to verbalize our needs as a way of keeping us submissive. He's not that petty. What He desires is communication — that's what really counts. That act of opening yourself up, of becoming vulnerable, of relying on Him, trusting Him. If it feels like God is asleep in your life, ask yourself this, have you tried waking Him up?

女士先生們，你們中的任何一個人，有沒有得到過無聲的對待，卻完全不知道為什麼嗎？請舉手一下。另一方面，你們中的任何一個人，能發誓在上千次的解說中你不會被重視過。例如：在孩子的足球練習之前，你需要有更多講解的幫忙，或者當你的配偶沒有問你今天過得如何時，你感覺被忽略了。

但可悲的是，愛並沒有賦予你閱讀人心理的能力。最後，我們一次又一次的得到了教訓。我們必須用言語表達我們的感情，我們的需要，我們的慾望，只是期待你伴侶，能預測你的需要將會以失敗告終。

上主亦然，雖然祂確實有能力讀懂你的心思，但祂仍希望我們自己像祂說明，不是嗎？“我對此感覺害怕。”“我真的很擔心。”主啊！我想我需要X, Y 和 Z，請幫幫我。”

耶穌在船上睡著了，船正被海浪拋擲和翻轉著，直到門徒把耶穌叫醒。問說“祢為什麼還在睡覺？”天才，祂還在睡覺是因為他們還沒把祂叫醒。他們浪費時間在畏縮和恐懼中，等待祂採取行動，但是他們置祂於沉默中等待而不自知，上主不希望我們只用言語表達我們的需求，得到滿足而以此來順從祂。祂不是小氣，祂所希望的是交流- 這才是重要的。是做開自己的心扉，展示脆弱，向祂依靠的這個行動。如果感覺上主在你的生活中睡著了，請反問自己，你是否試著去喚醒祂？

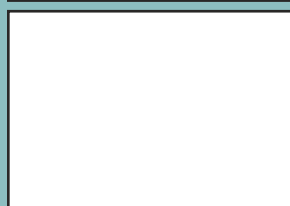

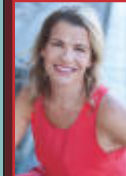
