Formación en la Fe *En el año que viene*

Este año, pasamos de lecciones individuales basadas en grados a un hermoso aprendizaje de la fe basado en la familia llamado “Una Familia de Fe”. Al principio lo hicimos para simplificar nuestro proceso de aprendizaje para que a los padres les resulte sencillo mantener a sus hijos comprometidos con su fe durante la pandemia, pero lo encontramos tan rico como una forma de permitir que nuestras familias crezcan juntas, que deseamos Continuar ofreciendo esto como el modelo principal de construir la fe para todas nuestras familias.

Antes de que su familia se registre para el próximo año, le pedimos que considere algunas cosas:

- **¿Cuándo puede su familia venir junta a la Catedral dos veces al mes para formarse en la fe?** (¿Sábados por la mañana o por la tarde? ¿Domingo antes o después de la Misa? ¿Noche de la semana?)
- **¿Cómo puede su familia convertir su hogar en la iglesia doméstica?** (es decir, ¿cuándo oramos juntos, tenemos signos de nuestra fe en el hogar para recordarnos a Dios? ¿Invitamos a Dios a ser no solo una parte de nuestra vida diaria, sino el centro?)
- **¿Está mi hijo listo para recibir los sacramentos?** ¿Cómo podemos prepararlos mejor para apreciar la vida espiritual de oración y sacramento? (es decir, ¿nosotros como padres modelamos la vida católica prestando atención a nuestra propia vida espiritual de oración, servicio y sacramentos? ¿Llevamos a nuestros hijos a Misa y nos confesamos regularmente? ¿Oramos con ellos?)

Faith Formation *In the Coming Year*

This year, we shifted from individual grade-based lessons to a beautiful family-based learning of faith called “A Family of Faith”. At first we did so to simplify our process of learning to make it simple for parents to keep their kids engaged in their faith during the pandemic, but we found it so rich as a way to allow our families to grow together, that we wish to continue to offer this as the primary model of building faith for all of our families. Before your family registers for this coming year, we ask that you consider a few things:

- **When can your family come to the Cathedral together twice a month to be formed in faith?** (i.e. Saturday mornings or afternoons? Sunday before or after Mass? Weeknight?)
- **How can your family make your home the domestic church?** (i.e. when do we pray together, do we have signs of our faith around the home to remind us of God? Do we invite God to be not just a part of our daily lives, but the center?)
- **Is my child ready to receive the Sacraments?** How can we better prepare them to appreciate the Spiritual Life of prayer and Sacrament? (i.e. do we as parents model the Catholic life by attending to our own spiritual life of prayer, service, and Sacraments? Do we take our children to Mass and confession regularly? Pray with them?)

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS -

St. Anthony Can Find Anything — Even You

"Tony, Tony, come around! Something is lost and it must be found." Did you learn this one when you were a kid? In my experience there are even a lot of lapsed Catholics — or people who were never Catholic at all — who know that when you lose something, St. Anthony becomes your best friend. Missing keys? Pray to St. Anthony. Can't find your favorite sweater? St. Anthony. Forget where you parked your car in the mall lot? St. Anth— okay, you get the idea. Whatever it is, large or small, important or trivial, Tony has a reputation for finding the lost things.

It's a devotion that can seem a little like superstition — witchcraft, even? — if you don't really understand it. Mumble an incantation to a dead guy and you're guaranteed to find your sunglasses. But as with most traditions that are old, beloved and effective, looking a little closer reveals the truth of the matter.

When we lose something really important, what do we do? We make the whole household stop what they're doing to join the search. Having St. Anthony as a friend means you ask him to stop what he's doing to help, too. And how he helps is by taking the matter exactly where all matters need to go — straight to the feet of Christ.

Here's the real genius of St Anthony: he takes the most mundane, commonplace occurrence — misplacing socks — into an encounter with the divine and truly all things great and small are gifts from God. He grabs our hand and points to the cross. "That's what you're looking for," he tells us. In the end, Tony doesn't really find the lost things. He finds the lost people.

"安東尼，安東尼，快點來，東西搞丟了，必須要找回它，" 你小時候曾經聽過如此一說嗎？以我的經驗，有很多曾經是天主教徒，或根本不是天主教徒，都知道如果東西丟失時，安東尼會是好幫手。例如：鑰匙遺失了？向聖安東尼祈禱，找不到心愛的毛衣？求聖安東尼，忘記將車停在購物中心停車場的何處？問聖安東尼。好的，你明瞭了。無論大小，重要或瑣碎，聖安東尼都因能找回丟失品而享有聲譽。

當我們丟失了真正重要的東西時，我們該怎麼辦？我們會讓

整個家庭成員停下他們手中的事情一起來搜尋，有個聖安東尼這個朋友，就可以請他一起來幫忙。他又是要如何來幫助呢，他就是精確的指出問題所需要處理之處- 就是直接帶到基督腳前。

聖安東尼真是天才，他能將最平凡的事，小到像襪子找不到之類的事情，凡是大大小小所有事物，能真實的與主相遇都是一種賜福，他握著我們的手指向十字架，告訴我們說：那就是你要尋找的東西。聖安東尼最後並沒有真正找到丟失的東西，他找到迷失的人。

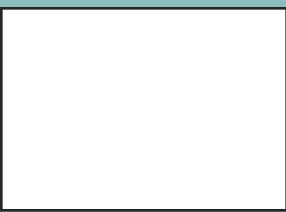

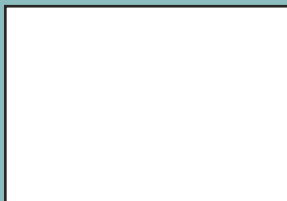

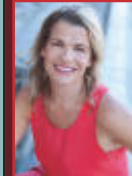
