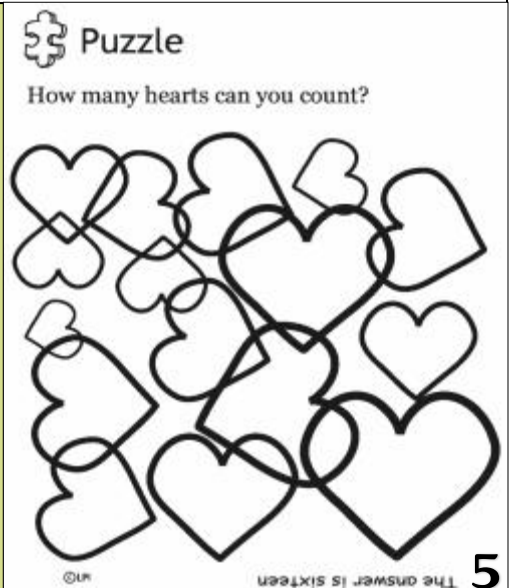


Cathedral Kids
