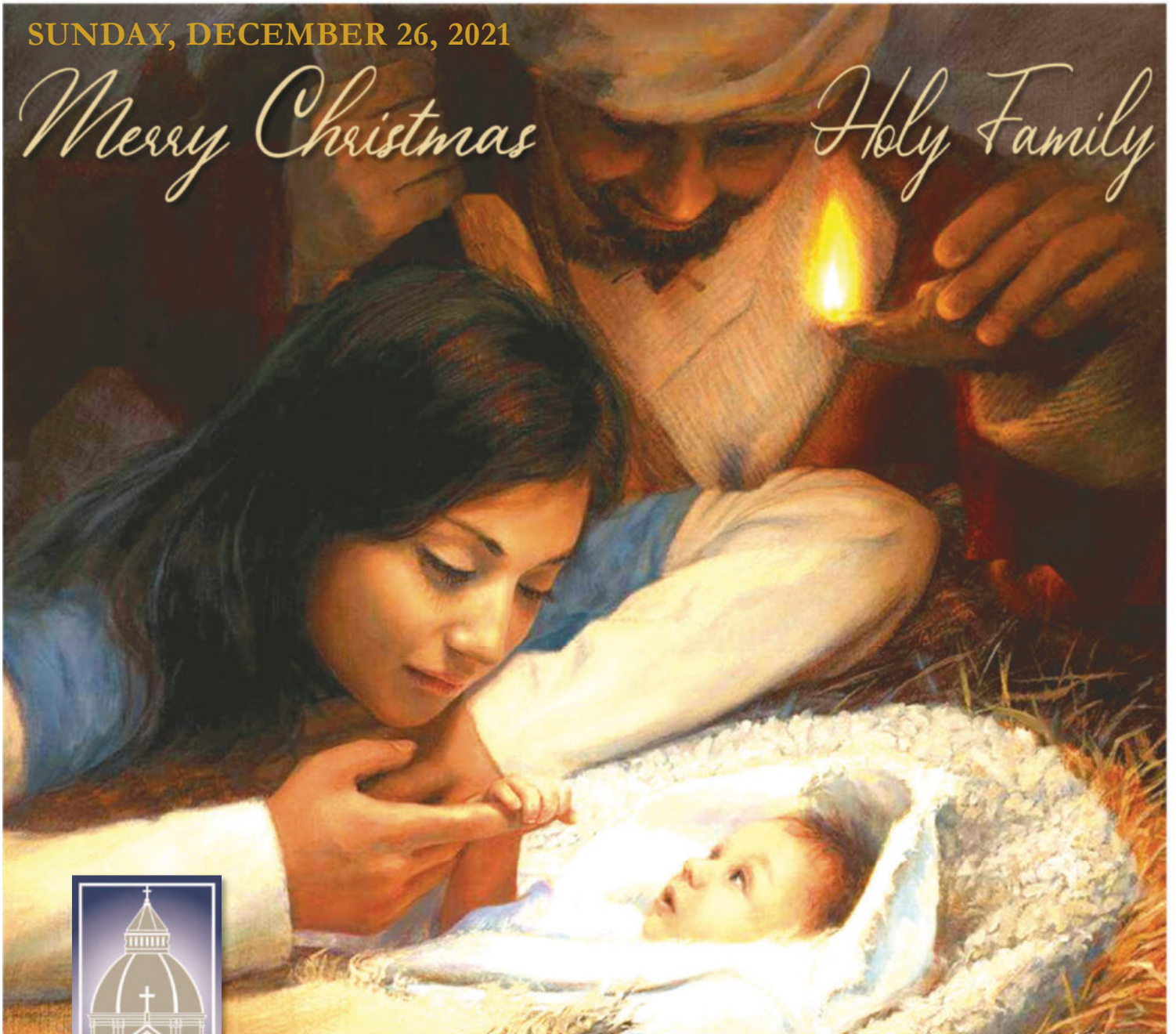

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

 The Holy Family experienced many of the same joys and trials that all parents and children experience today. And, so, we can look to this Family for help in our own family lives and see in them a model of stewardship in family life.

The Gospel passage from Luke starts by telling us something about Jesus' parents: "Each year Jesus' parents went to Jerusalem for the feast of the Passover, and when he was 12 years old, they went up according to festival custom." This Family took seriously the stewardship of their time. The "Holy Couple" carefully observed the traditions and practice of their Jewish faith and brought up their Son to do the same. They worshiped as a family, and with their faith community. And they did so faithfully.

We can take their example to heart by making Sunday Mass attendance a priority for our families, by making prayer with our family a priority every day, by making sure that we regularly celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and by observing in our family life the feasts and fasts appropriate to the liturgical calendar. When we, as families, prioritize our Time with God and worship of Him we will be imitating the Holy Family.

On this Feast of the Holy Family, let us reclaim the beauty and importance of family life. Let's commit to steward our families well in 2022, making time spent with God and practicing our faith the most important

Jesus is Born!

Christmas is one of the most important days in the year. We know that it's Jesus' birthday, but let's think a bit more about what that means...

Who is Jesus? He is God. He is also a real man. When Adam and Eve sinned they lost the privilege of going to Heaven. Now people needed to pay back for their sins, but no sacrifice they could make could ever be big enough. Only a perfect man could make a perfect sacrifice. And because God loved us so much He became a man to die for us!



Now think about God, Who made Himself a little baby, coming down to our world. He had a poor mother and foster father, and He was born in a little barn, far away from their home. The first people who came to visit were the rough men who lived in the fields, looking after their sheep.

God loved us so much that He made Himself into a poor baby. Doesn't that just make you want to love Him more? Today or in the next few days, spend some time looking at a creche (a nativity scene) and think about Baby Jesus and how much God loves us.

A Glimpse of Spirituality (靈修一瞥) Fr. Abraham Chiu (趙必成神父)

In God, there is only love; in love, there is only grace; and in grace, there is eternal life.

The Blessed Virgin Mary is assigned by God the mission of God, i.e., being the mother of God.

Therefore, her whole person has been living in God's grace when she was conceived in her mother's womb.

That is the project of God's salvation.

When the angel conveyed the mission of God to Mary, Gabriel said: "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you!"

The passive verb of "full of grace" (kecharitōmenē) is not meant as "being full." "Being full" is still a quantitative calculation. The literal translation of the Greek verb "kecharitōmenē" should be "to be favored," or simply said, "to be graced." In other words, Mary lives in the grace of God and is not at all related to sin.

Mary is already saved in anticipation even though Jesus has not been born and resurrected from the dead. In the perfect grace of God, Mary is created and called to be the mother of God.

We see from the Immaculate Conception that Mary lives for Jesus with all her life. As her children, we are called to follow our heavenly mother's good example as to live for God with all our lives.

天主內，只有愛，在愛里面，只有恩寵，在恩寵當中，只有永生。

聖母，因為她被委任天主使命，成為天主之母，因此，整個人在天主救贖工程當中，早就活在天主恩寵。

天使給瑪利亞傳遞天主使命的時候，說：“萬福！充滿恩寵者，上主與你同在！”

“充滿恩寵者” (kecharitōmenē) 這個被動語態動詞，本意不是“充滿”，“充滿”還是有數量的計算，從不滿到充滿，是數量評估。希臘詞“kecharitōmenē”直譯是“被恩寵化”；意即瑪利亞整個人都活在天主恩寵當中，沒有絲毫與罪惡有關。

縱然耶穌還沒降生以及死而復活，天主恩寵卻沒有時空限制，因此，在天主恩寵當中，瑪利亞被創造，並且被召叫成為天主之母。

表面上耶穌在聖母胎中，其實，是聖母在天主聖三的恩寵裡面，是天主讓瑪利亞脫離罪惡，與耶穌合作，完成救贖工程。

聖母無玷始胎，這特恩不是為她，而是為降生成人的耶穌基督。

聖母一輩子，都為耶穌而活。讓我們效法聖母榜樣，一生為主而活。

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS - Stewardship Ties

There is a lot of imagery around Christmas that has to do with adoption — or, more specifically, with a child being loved by another as if they belonged to that person and loved in such a profound way that in time, they do come to belong to that person.

We see this with Joseph and the infant Jesus. Joseph is not Jesus' biological father. But through a series of actions, and through his faithfulness in small, everyday matters, Joseph becomes the foster father of Jesus.

Perhaps we are parents who have adopted children, or we ourselves were adopted. We have also seen how, through a series of actions of love and sacrifice, someone can become the parent of a person who is not their "blood." A lot of times these families celebrate the day of the adoption. I've heard it called a "gotcha day," and it's marked joyously, like a birthday.

Most of us are not descended from the Israelites, God's Chosen People. But through a series of extraordinary actions of love and sacrifice, God has made Himself our parent, too. And through our own actions, and through faithfulness in small and everyday matters, we are His children.

But in this family, instead of blood ties, we have stewardship ties. It's not about who we look like, it's about how we treat one another. How we take care of one another.

So this Christmas, let's think about how we will celebrate our adoption. As much as it is Jesus' birthday, it's also our "gotcha day" — the day we received the gift of eternal family.

每日當責 - 在日常生活中體會天主- 上主僕人的關係

圍繞著聖誕節有很多的意象與收養有關 - 或者，更具體的說，就像一個被人愛的孩子，他們就像是屬於那個人的一樣，並被如此深刻的愛著，以至於時間日久，他們便確實地屬於那個人了。

我們在若瑟和嬰兒耶穌身上看到了這一點。若瑟不是耶穌的親生父親，但是透過一系列的行動，以及經過他在日常小事上的忠誠，若瑟成了耶穌的養父。

也許我們是收養孩子的父母親，或者我們自己是被收養的，我們也看到了，透過一系列愛和犧牲的愛，一個人如何成為一個不是他們"血統"的人的父母，很多時候，這些家庭都會慶祝這個收養日，我聽說它被稱作"gotcha day"，這天被當作快樂日子的

標記，就像過生日一樣。

我們大多數人都不是以色列人的後裔，是上主的選民，但是透過一系列非凡的愛和犧牲的行動，上主讓自己也已成為我們的父母，透過我們自己的行動，在經過日常小事上的忠誠，我們成為祂的孩子。

但是在這個家庭中，我們由上主僕人的關聯取代血緣的關聯，這不是關於我們長得如何相像，而是關於我們如何對待彼此，我們如何互相照顧。

所以這個聖誕節，讓我們想想將要如何慶祝我們的收養日，就像耶穌的生日，這也是我們的"收養日" - 是我們收到永恆家庭禮物的一天。 — Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS
