THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

The **mystery of the Holy Trinity** is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son, Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods, but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one Divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son, and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others.

Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

Christians baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity illumines all of the other mysteries of faith.

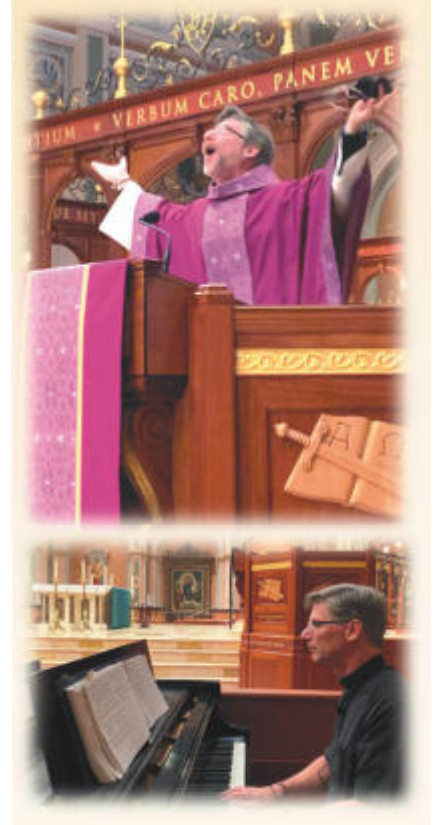

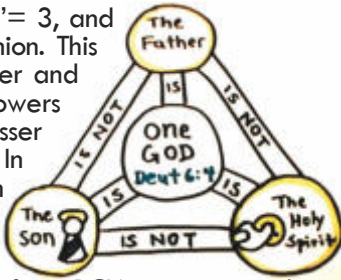

Glory to the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen!

This week...

This weekend we honor the Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In our profession of Faith—and when we make the Sign of the Cross—we proclaim our belief in One God, in three distinct persons. The Creed tells us who these three persons are. We state: “I believe in God the (1) Father Almighty ... (2) Jesus Christ the Only Son our Lord ... and (3) the Holy Spirit ...” We have heard that God is “*Triune*”. Meaning: “Tri”= 3, and “union” + unity. God is 3 in 1 communion. This unity that Jesus experiences with the Father and the Son is one that he longs that we (followers of Jesus) might experience—on a lesser degree—with our brothers and sisters. In John, chapter 17, Jesus prays “Ut unum sint...” or “That they (we believers in Jesus) may all be one.”




This Sunday, we welcome three members of our RCIA community who have professed Trinitarian faith in other Christian denominations but have sought union with the Catholic Church. Let us pray for and welcome Barbara Leake, Larry Lavik and Rebecca King who will be confirmed and will receive Holy Communion at the 10 am Mass this Sunday. Welcome to the Cathedral Community and to the fullness of the Catholic faith!

Este fin de semana honramos a la Santísima Trinidad, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. En nuestra profesión de fe, y cuando hacemos la Señal de la Cruz, proclamamos nuestra fe en un solo Dios, en tres personas distintas. El Credo nos dice quiénes son estas tres personas. Decimos: “Creo en Dios el (1) Padre Todopoderoso... (2) Jesucristo el Hijo Unigénito nuestro Señor... y (3) el Espíritu Santo...” Hemos escuchado que Dios es “Trino”. Significado: “Tri” = 3 y “unión” + unidad. Dios es comunión 3 en 1. Esta unidad que Jesús experimenta con el Padre y el Hijo es algo que él anhela que nosotros (seguidores de Jesús) podamos experimentar, en menor grado, con nuestros hermanos y hermanas. En Juan, capítulo 17, Jesús ora “Ut unum sint ...” o “Para que (nosotros los creyentes en Jesús) todos sean uno”.


Este domingo, damos la bienvenida a tres miembros de nuestra comunidad de RICA que han profesado la fe trinitaria en otras denominaciones cristianas, pero desean estar unidos en la comunión de la fe católica. Oremos y demos la bienvenida a Barbara Leake, Larry Lavik y Rebecca King, quienes serán confirmados y recibirán la Sagrada Comunión en la misa de las 10 am de este domingo. ¡Bienvenidos a la Comunidad de la Catedral y a la plenitud de la fe católica!

¿Quién es la Santísima Trinidad?

La Santísima Trinidad—el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo—es el misterio central de nuestra Fe. Cuando hablamos de la Santísima Trinidad, estamos profesando dos creencias: creencia en la unidad de Dios (que hay un sólo Dios) y creencia en la Trinidad de Dios (que hay tres Personas Divinas, iguales y distintas, en Dios). Cuando decimos que hay tres Personas distintas en Dios, queremos decir que una Persona no es la otra Persona y sin embargo todas las tres Personas son un Dios. La Trinidad es una comunión de Personas—un intercambio eterno de amor. Dios es una familia, y la familia de Dios es amor que da vida. Cuando somos bautizados, entramos en esta familia como los hijos adoptivos de Dios. Nos convertimos en partícipes en la vida divina de Dios y somos llamados a entrar en una comunión de amor en este mundo como un signo y testigo de la comunión divina que existe en la Trinidad. La palabra Trinidad no aparece en la Biblia, pero el Señor nos habla sobre esta verdad. Uno

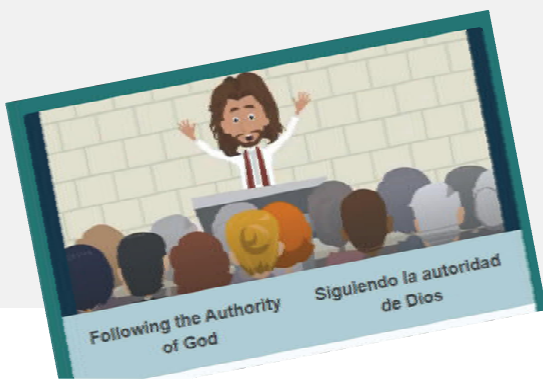

Our Faith:
Who is the Most Holy Trinity?

The Most Holy Trinity—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—is the central mystery of our Faith. When we speak of the Blessed Trinity, we are professing two beliefs: belief in the unity of God (that there is only one God) and belief in the Trinity of God (that there are three equal, distinct Divine Persons in God). When we say that there are three distinct Persons in God we mean that one Person is not the other Person, and yet all three are one God. The Trinity is a communion of persons — an eternal exchange of love. God is a family, and God’s family life is life-giving love. When we are baptized, we enter this family as God’s adopted children. We become partakers of the divine life of God and are called to enter into loving communion in this world as a sign and witness to the divine communion existing in the Trinity. The word Trinity does not appear in the Bible, but the Lord clearly speaks to us about this truth. One of the clearest examples is in Matthew 28:19, when Jesus tells His disciples, “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.”

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS- GOD DOESN'T TAKE A BREAK

An acquaintance who works in church ministry once told me a story about one of the students she had in Faith Formation. This student informed my friend that his family doesn't come to Mass in summer. "God takes a break in summer, and so do we," he said.

There's a lot to unpack here. First, it's tragic to think of anyone voluntarily missing out on the Eucharist for so long. It's also a real problem in the church today that a lot of our folks don't understand the beauty of the Sunday obligation. But if I had to dissect this situation and pinpoint the thing I find most troubling, it's the idea of God taking a break.

I hope it's starting to look like summer where you are. We've still got a few weeks left before it's official, but the school year should be winding up for most kids, the birds should be chirping a little louder, and hopefully your lawn is starting to green up nicely. You're probably daydreaming about the annual cabin getaway weekend or water skiing on the Fourth of July. All in all, summer is going to be a nice break, even if — like typical Americans — our break is full of productive work.

Thank God — literally — that He doesn't take a break, even if we do. Can we try to remember that, even in the midst of our many wonderful distractions? Let's enjoy this summer. Let's live it to the full. But let's see it for the gift that it is — and remember the thanks we owe the Giver.

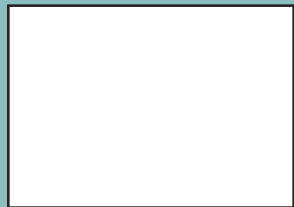

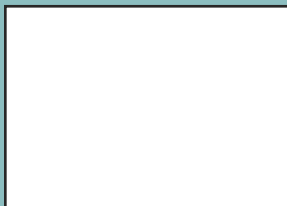

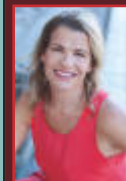
