He told her to have a painting made of what she saw with the words "Jesus I trust in You," and that the Sunday after Easter should be devoted to His mercy, He taught her a prayer called the Divine Mercy Chaplet.

Family Reflection  
*The Resurrection  
of the Body*

### I BELIEVE

When we say we believe in the resurrection of the body, we mean that not only will our souls live forever, but our physical bodies will, too. As we have learned, our bodily death is a consequence of Original Sin. Death is the end of earthly life and allows us to participate in the death of Christ, so we can also share in His Resurrection. Jesus conquered death by His Death and Resurrection, and in His Resurrection is the hope of ours. “Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day (John 6:54). On the Last Day, Christ will raise the bodies of all people from the dead and reunite them with their souls. Life Everlasting When we state our belief in life everlasting, we mean that life lasts forever—either in Heaven or in hell. While we are alive on earth we can choose to accept or reject God’s grace. At our death, we will be judged and enter Heaven (through purification or directly), or hell. This is called the particular judgment. St. John of the Cross said of it, “In the evening of life, we shall be judged on our love.” Those who die in God’s grace will live forever in the glory of Heaven: the perfect life with the Blessed Trinity, the Virgin Mary, the angels, and the saints. The glory of Heaven is called the beatific vision because we will be able to contemplate God as He is. “At present we see indistinctly, as in a mirror, but then face to face” (1 Corinthians 13:12). “They will see his face” (Revelation 22:4). Unlike earthly satisfaction or pleasure, which is temporary, in Heaven we will be satisfied in our desire to be satisfied—Heaven is the ultimate end and fulfillment of the deepest human longings, the state of supreme, definitive happiness (CCC 1024).

### CREO

Cuando decimos que creemos en la resurrección del cuerpo, significa que no solamente nuestras almas vivirán eternamente, sino que también nuestros cuerpos físicos lo harán. Como hemos aprendido, nuestra muerte corporal es una consecuencia del pecado original. La muerte es el fin de la vida en la tierra y nos permite participar en la muerte de Cristo, para que también podamos compartir su Resurrección. Jesús venció a la muerte por su Muerte y Resurrección, y en su Resurrección está nuestra esperanza. “El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre vive de vida eterna, y yo lo resucitaré el último día” (Juan 6, 54). En el último día, Cristo resucitará de entre los muertos los cuerpos de todas las personas y los reunirá con sus almas. La vida eterna Cuando decimos que creemos en la vida eterna, significa que la vida dura para la eternidad, ya sea en el cielo o en el infierno. Cuando vivimos en la tierra, podemos elegir aceptar o rechazar la gracia de Dios. A la hora de nuestra muerte seremos juzgados y entraremos al cielo (mediante la purificación o directamente) o al infierno. Esto se conoce como el juicio particular. San Juan de la Cruz dijo, “En el atardecer de la vida, seremos juzgados en el amor”. Aquellos que mueren en gracia de Dios vivirán por siempre en la gloria del cielo: la vida perfecta con la Santísima Trinidad, la Virgen María, los ángeles y los santos. La gloria del cielo se llama “visión beatífica” porque podremos contemplar a Dios tal cual es. “En el momento presente vemos las cosas como en un espejo, confusamente, pero entonces las veremos cara a cara” (1 Corintios 13, 12). “Verán su rostro” (Apocalipsis 22, 4). A diferencia del placer o la satisfacción terrena, que es temporal, en el cielo se satisfará nuestro deseo de ser satisfechos. “El cielo es el fin último y la realización de las aspiraciones más profundas del hombre, el estado supremo y definitivo de dicha” (CIC 1024).

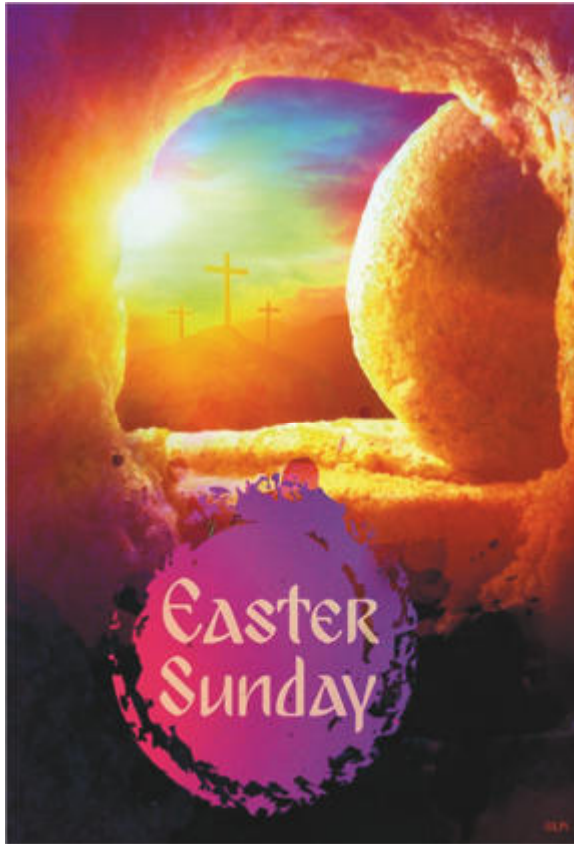
### RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS - A Happy Ending Isn't the Whole Story

"Is there a happy ending?" When my kids were young, we never made it past the first whiff of any narrative tension before I got this question. As soon as whatever princess or furry woodland animal who was the hero of the story got into any small scrape, they wanted that reassurance, "Is there a happy ending?"

I can't say I blame them. Don't we all feel that way sometimes? We enter into a relationship with someone or some situation, and we just want to protect ourselves. We want to know it's not going to go badly — or, if it does, that we will be able to come back from it. It's a human instinct, a reflex. Our inclination to protect ourselves makes it so that we sometimes want to press fast-forward on the bad stuff and skip straight ahead to the happily-ever-after.

Easter is the ultimate happy ending. It's the day of miracles. The day when all the stones roll away and all the sins are forgiven. It's the day that puts everything right.

But if we learned anything from this week — from the Passion and death of the Lord — it's that we can't press fast-forward on the hardships of life. That tension, that loss, that fear — it's crucial, isn't it? As Catholics, we are who we are because of Easter. But Easter doesn't happen without Good Friday. So, does the story of salvation have a happy ending? We know it does. But we also remember that the ending isn't all that matters. — Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS

關重要的過程，不是嗎? 作為天主教徒，復活節就是我們的源頭，一但沒有耶穌的受難，就沒有復活節。

所以救贖的故事是否有個幸福圓滿的結局? 我們知道是有的，但是我們也要記住，結局並不是故事的全部重點。

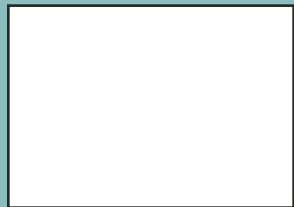

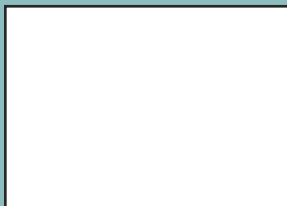
