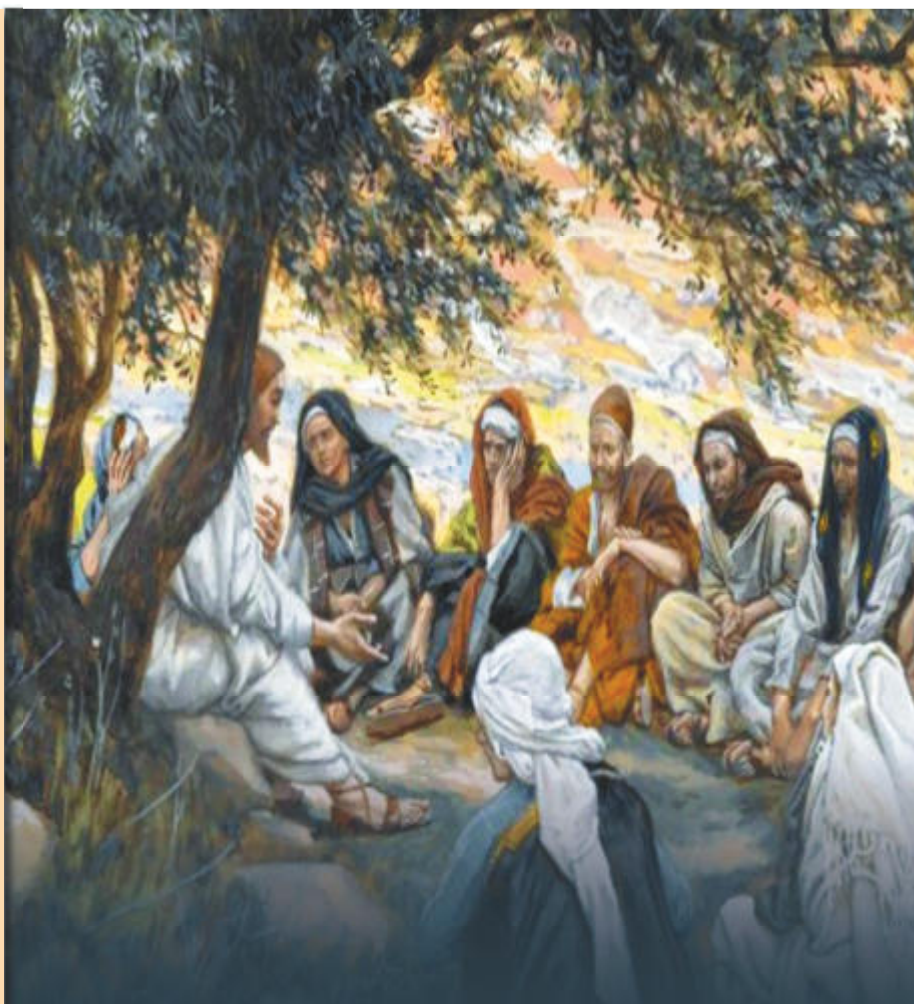

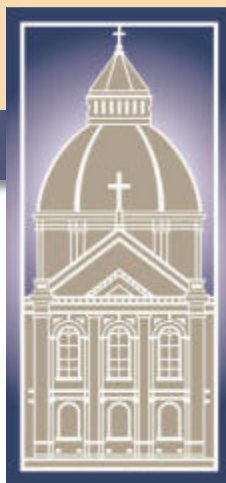

- **Remain where you are.** At the time of Communion, stay in your place. The priest or minister of the sacrament will come to you. Please stand when to receive.
- **Receive in the Hand if you can.** The Church asks that you receive in the hand to lessen the potential contact.

The PASTOR'S Corner



My Pastor's corner for this Sunday is rather short, after all, it is Father's Day. I was given permission to relax.

Jesus reminds us that the Father is aware of the life and death of every sparrow, birds which are so numerous that our eyes cannot detect any difference between them. Celebrating our Spiritual Fathers

As we remember Fathers in a special way this weekend, we would be amiss if we overlooked those fathers who we have recourse to in the spiritual life. The first and foremost is God the Father whom we honor with our daily praying of the Lord's Prayer. Jesus shows us the way to the Father, and in fact reminds the disciple Philip that "...whoever has seen me has seen the Father" (John 14:9). We honor God the Father in many ways when at Mass, and it is good to reflect on these. Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we honor the Father along with the Son Jesus and the Holy Spirit. When we pray the Creed, we profess our belief in "...God the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and Earth." And, at the end of Eucharistic Prayer we pray the prayer Jesus himself taught us, the Our Father.

The second is the protector of the Universal Church and head of the Holy Family, beloved Saint Joseph. He models the love of God for us through his care for Jesus, showing us the relationship our Heavenly Father wants with us. We learn to trust God in seeing the child Jesus entrust Himself completely to the care of Saint Joseph.

Lastly, we have our Pastors, who are given to us to help us spiritually through this life. They, like Saint Joseph, model the role of Fathers. They provide wise counsel in the confessional, provide spiritual nourishment in the Eucharist, and prays for us as head of your church community. Fr. Michael, thank you!

Let us honor all of our fathers today, and thank the Lord for their roles in our spiritual and earthly life.

El primero y más importante es Dios el Padre, a quien honramos con nuestra oración diaria de la Oración del Señor. 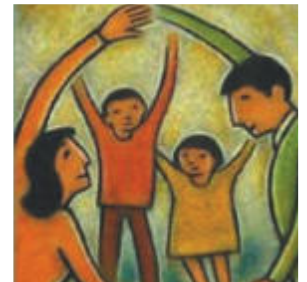

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP-RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS **Will You Say Yes?**

You find yourself in the difficult situation of being accused of blasphemy and confronting possible execution. Your crime is believing in Jesus Christ. The question is then asked of you, "Are you a Christian, a follower of the one named Jesus Christ?" Your answer may very well dictate what happens to you next. What is your answer? It is probably easier to answer this question when the scenario is make-believe. All of us want to believe that we would say yes to the question of belief in Jesus, but strange things happen when humans panic in the face of extreme stress. As we reflect on what we would say, there are those all over the world who are being asked that very same question. It is a question that was asked of many in the first centuries of the Church. Those who respond "yes" are considered martyrs and saints.

We might not usually think of all this in terms of good stewardship living. However, our faith is also a gift we have received from God to cultivate, grow, and share with others. The more interesting question than the one posed above is, "Would an accuser even think of asking you such a question?" Would you have cultivated, grown, and shared your faith enough that anyone would even consider you worthy of asking the question? They might assume you don't know Jesus Christ at all. I don't like conflict and do not seek out conflict, but I would rather someone ask the first question posed than assume there is no reason to confront me in the first place.

每日當責 - 在日常生活中體會天主

你會說 "是的"嗎?

當你發現自己處於被指控褻瀆罪並面臨可能被處決的困境，而你的罪名是相信耶穌基督。你被問的問題是，你是基督徒嗎？是耶穌基督的信徒嗎？而你的答案將決定你的後果，你的答案會是甚麼？

當確信是假設的問題時，回答可能容易些。相信所有的人，都希望對回答是否信仰基督的問題時說"是的"，但是當人們面對極端壓力的恐慌時，就會發生奇怪的事了。世界各地的人都曾被問到同樣的問題，當我們思考我們要回答的話時，來看看教會在最初幾個世紀，曾被問過的這個問題，那些回答"是的"的人都被尊為烈士和聖人了。

我們通常不會以良好忠信生活角度的來考慮所有事情。但是，我們的信德是從天主而來的禮物，可用以培養，成長及和他人分享的禮物。比上面提出更有趣的問題是，"原提問的人甚至會想問你這樣的問題嗎？"你是否已經有足夠地培養，成長和分享你的信德呢？人們甚至不認為值得對你提出這個問題。他們可能假設你根本不認識耶穌基督。我不喜歡衝突，也不尋求衝突，但我寧願有人問我第一個問題，而不是假設沒有理由首先來確認我是否是基督徒。

HOLY EUCHARIST
