STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

The readings for the Second Week of Advent offer both encouragement and challenge as we reflect and prepare for the two “comings” of Christ — His coming as a baby on the great feast of Christmas, and the anticipation of His second coming at the end of time.

Our First Reading, from Baruch, is a wonderful reminder that God has triumphed over sin and death and that we — His faithful disciples — will live in the light of His glory one day. Until He comes again, we must remain faithful to Him as true disciples and good stewards of all the gifts He has given us.

While it can be tempting to give in to the materialism and calls for self-indulgence that surround us, this reading calls us back to the spiritual reality that this life is passing and that we are made for eternal life with God. We are called to prepare for eternal life by the way that we use our time, our talents, and our treasure now.

The Gospel reading from Luke shows us how personal and detailed is God’s love for humanity as He prepared the way for Christ’s coming among us. We are told the precise time, place, and person, John the Baptist, He appointed to announce the arrival of our Savior. John tells us how to celebrate to the fullest this first “coming” on the feast of Christmas and how to prepare for the second coming — through repentance.

This Advent let’s turn away from any bad habits or sin that may have crept into our lives and turn our hearts and minds back to Christ. This is what the stewardship way of life is all about — moving closer ever closer in relationship with Christ and imitation of Him, ready to celebrate His birth, with eyes fixed on eternal life with Him.



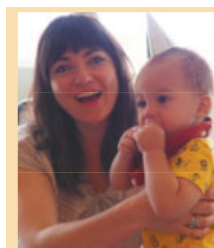

Wednesday December 8, 2021

12:10 pm & 5 pm English | 7 pm Spanish

The Solemnity of the Conception of Mary falls nine months before her birth on September 8. A summary of Church teaching on this solemnity may be found in today's Preface which reflects Vatican II's document *Lumen Gentium*. First, Mary was free from sin from the moment she was conceived. Second, Mary, as a sign of the Church, is the bride of Christ, radiant in beauty (Eph 5: 27). Third, the purity of Mary emanates from the innocence of the Lamb. And fourth, Mary was predestined to be the advocate of grace and the model of sanctity for the People of God. We come to Mass today with the words of the angel Gabriel echoing in our hearts:

“Blessed are we among the people because we have been chosen to bring Him into the world anew today.”

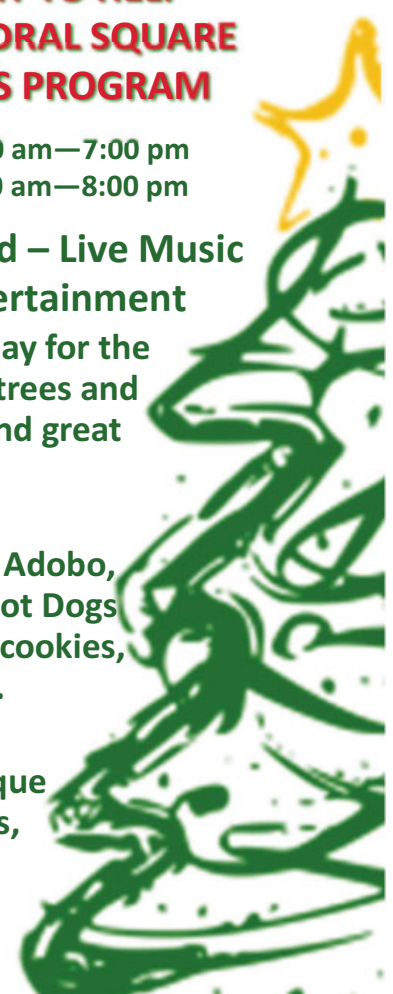

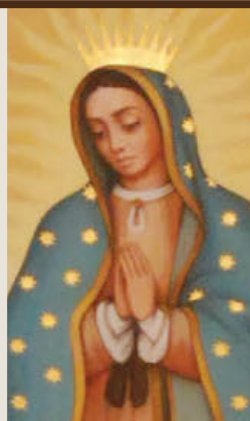

Sacramento, take off your robe of mourning and misery; put on the splendor of glory from God forever. Yes, God speaks to us when we read the Bible. Wearing “the splendor of God” and revealing His Glory has been challenging while we discern how best to deal with the spread of the virus and the loss of lives during this time. Nevertheless, difficult, and sometimes tragic events such as what we have been going through should never overshadow the great event that took place and continues to happen in the person of Jesus the Christ. We “put on Christ” and understand that the old order, the old darkness, the old sin no longer has power over us, death no longer has a sting.

What does it mean, then, to put on the splendor of God? What does it look like? Jesus, throughout His life, gives us His example. Through the hardships of culture, He simply lived and trusted in the Father. Through the rejection of family and friends, He simply lived and trusted in the Father. Through the accusations and lies, He simply lived and trusted in the Father. Through the sickness and death, He simply lived and trusted in the Father. Jesus so utterly wore the splendor of God that His every action and choice was God. His grace has been given to each one of us in order for us to live that same splendor. Our flesh must be clothed with the splendor of the glory of God so that “all flesh shall see the salvation of God.”

Whenever we deny death, we inevitably deny eternal life because we consider growing old as an evil thing, rather than as a green leaf from a loving God.

Let no one frighten us with disturbing descriptions of the end of the world because “the end” is all about the birth of everyone and everything into eternity.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

God's Personal Assistants

If you have ever planned a large-scale event, whether it's a musical performance or a religious conference, you may have dealt with someone's personal assistant. Possibly this person would be a representative of the keynote speaker or the master of ceremonies for the local bishop; perhaps it's even the staffer of a local politician or the lackey of a well-known musical act.

Personal assistants are masters of stewardship — overseeing things in their boss' absence. They prepare the way.

This person's job is to get everything ready for the person in charge, so that when he or she shows up — whoever he or she is — it's smooth sailing for them to do whatever it is they need to do: sing, speak, pray, mingle, what-have-you. It's usually a big job full of little things, a gig where attention to detail is key.

God is the guest of honor in our life, the keynote speaker, the main event. And what He wants — what He needs — to do is to change our hearts. Constantly, over, and over, and over again.

We are all His personal assistants in this endeavor. We need to prepare the way of the Lord, to make straight His paths. We need to make everything ready so that when He shows up — however He shows up, whether it's in the form of a neighbor in need or a burning bush right in front of us — everything is ready for Him to do His job.

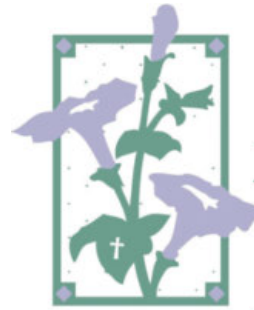
