

"I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do vou believe this?"


She said to him, "Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world."



### EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP -RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

When Our Own Hour Comes We parents know that it's tricky, tackling the topic of fear with our kids. We want them to know that it's okay to be scared, that it's something we all feel from time to time. We want them to understand that bravery isn't the absence of fear, but the choices we make in persevering despite that feeling. Most of all, we want to model the right kind of behavior for our kids. Whatever our scary situation is -we want them to see us make a choice to face that fear head-on. Jesus seems to be the parent who is gently broaching the topic of fear with his children. A great sense of hangs over these readings. Jesus knew what was coming. He knew it was going to be hard, both for him and for his followers, who did not have his courage. Even he admits to being "troubled" and he speaks of "the time of judgment." There is the dramatic raising of

This week, Christ gives us a very parental gift: He shows us his fear, and he shows us how to conquer it. He challenges us to embrace the purpose for which we came to this hour — whatever that hour may hold.
