STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today's readings offer us a message of hope —

God is with us and wants to heal us. May this message come ablaze in our hearts so that we might live with unwavering faith.

The Gospel presents us with the story of the profound physical healing of a deaf man with a speech impediment. People brought him to Jesus and begged for his healing. Jesus took the man off by himself, touched his ears and his tongue, then proclaimed, "Be opened!" Immediately he was healed.

This story in our Gospel overwhelms us with comfort and peace because we have a compassionate God who sees our physical needs. Yet if we reflect further on this reading, we see that God uses this moment of physical healing as an opportunity to restore something much deeper — our souls.

Often, we are blind and deaf to God in our lives. We miss countless opportunities to see God working in our day-to-day moments — through our loved ones, our community, or even a stranger. We miss the quiet voice of Jesus in our hearts telling us to choose Him instead of sin, respond in love instead of anger, or care for someone else in a moment instead of ourselves.

These are how we need to be spiritually healed. And the scriptures remind us that God is with us and wants to heal us.

This week let us seek God to heal our souls and transform our hearts. Let us pray that our eyes and our ears might "be open" to His workings, words, and promptings in our lives.

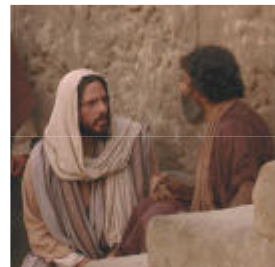

STEWARDSHIP RENEWAL

A Steward is Grateful

Gratitude is the necessary response to a gift. The heart of the Christian steward is gratitude. As Christian stewards, it is of utmost importance that we see God as the great gift-giver and thank Him for all He has given us. In fact, that is where our lives as Christian stewards ought to begin, because without Him, we have nothing. This is the basis of our stewardship way of life: a thanksgiving. Just as the Eucharist (thanksgiving) is the source and summit of our Catholic faith, our gratitude to God is the foundation of our stewardship way of life.

What is Stewardship Renewal?

This is a spiritual endeavor. Stewardship Renewal is a positive and formational time during which parishioners put all of their trust in Christ and take concrete steps in their faith, by making spiritual commitments of time, talent, and treasure. This is a grace-filled time for spiritual growth, both for you as an individual and the parish.

Why should I make a commitment?

During this time you will reflect on making commitments to prayer, parish ministries, and offertory giving, or what we call “time, talent, and treasure.” There’s a reason to make this commitment. It is an excellent opportunity to move forward spiritually and personally in your relationship with Christ.

Spiritual Journey of Renewal

United in Christ, we are on a journey to become a true community of disciples. Pray and reflect on your deep connection and commitment to Christ, the source of our strength and the inspiration for all that we are called to do.

To truly discern what He is asking each of us as individual Christian stewards — and our parish as a whole — you must be intentional in listening to His call. That means listening everyday, of course. Focus your prayer on deepening your relationship with Christ. Every day, God calls each one of us to follow Him, to put Him first in our lives.

What is stewardship?

Stewardship is the grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God’s gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor.





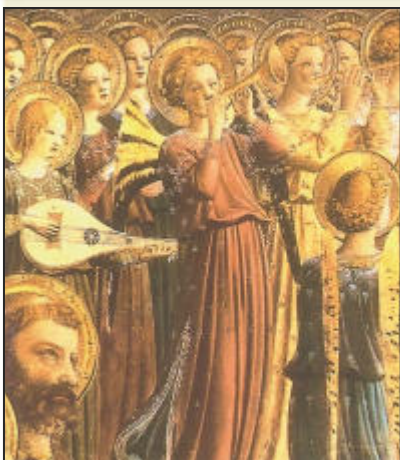

It is strange that when reading the Gospel of St. Mark, Jesus often tells the people not to say anything about him. We see today in the Gospel reading that Jesus ordered people not to say anything about the healing of a deaf man with a speech impediment. It seems a contradiction that Jesus, who heals a man of a speech impediment then tells him not to speak. I'm sure the man found it very difficult not to say anything and St. Mark tells us that everyone was spreading the news about Jesus everywhere. Jesus knew that the people weren't ready to understand his full purpose, but it was hard to keep such beautiful acts of love a secret.

Of course, as we walk closer with Jesus, we realize that talking about Jesus is exactly what we are supposed to do. There no longer is any reason to remain silent because Jesus has fully revealed Himself in suffering on the cross and rising from the dead. As we try to be enthusiastic disciples of Jesus, we are compelled to share the Good News and let everyone know about how God embraces our lives. As stewards of the great encounters we have with God, by sharing them with others we allow those still in the dark to experience the beauty of Christ the Light.

Throughout this month of September we at the Cathedral are given the chance to examine how well we have been sharing the story of our faith. To go out and tell the nations involves using the resources God has given us through time, talents, and treasures. On many levels, we have been sharing the story throughout our lives. This month, through our stewardship renewal, we make a deliberate choice to examine where we have been doers of His word and where we could offer more of ourselves. Christ assures us that the more we empty ourselves in love for God and neighbor, the more we experience the joy of being filled with His love.

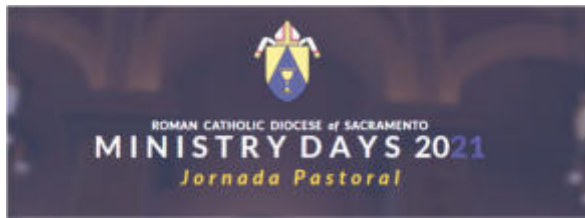

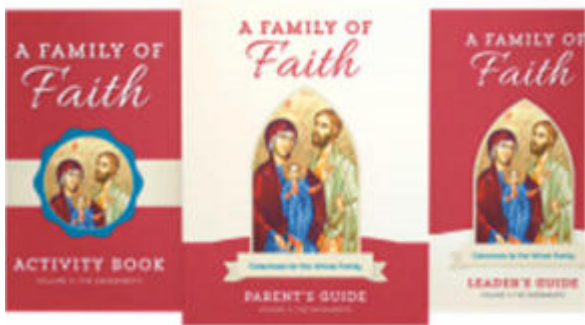


SEP 18, 2021 FOR High School Youth and Young Adults

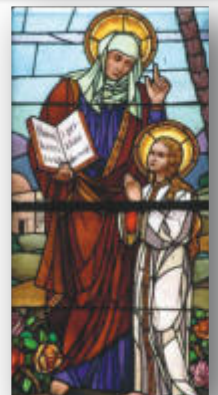

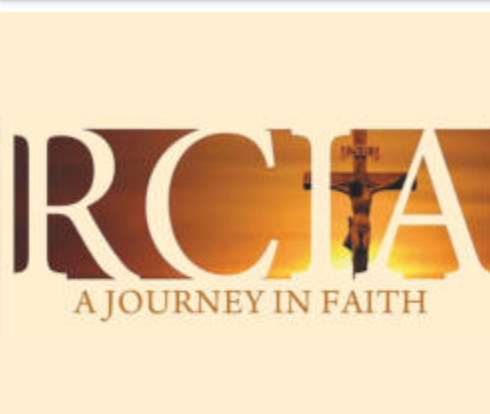

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS - Choosing Deafness

If you're a parent, you know that hearing evaluations are usually done at a child's annual physical exam starting around age four. The little person gets hoisted up onto the exam table, fitted with a pair of special headphones, and then they need to raise their hand when they hear a sound.

I bet all of us parents who have sat through one of these tests with a preschooler — especially a particularly strong-willed one — have experienced a moment where we ask ourselves: I wonder if there's something wrong with her hearing. Is that why she doesn't listen to me? 'Come here, put on your shoes, pick up your toys, finish your carrots, don't touch that' — she isn't being naughty, she just can't hear it!

And then that moment, for those of us whose kids passed the hearing test with flying colors, comes crashing down into a realization that, yep, they can hear just fine. They're just choosing deafness.

But how can we really get mad when we remember that we do the same thing to God day in and day out? I often wonder if God, sitting in His Heaven, tires of calling to us in the same way young parents tire of calling out unheeded directions to their small children. Help that person. Hear My voice. Open your heart. Give of yourself here. Talk to Me.

What is the call He wishes you to hear today? Can you hear it? Are you listening?

但是，當我們憶起日復一日，我們對上主也作了同樣的事情，我常想著坐在天國的上主，是否厭倦了召叫我們，就像年輕的父母，厭倦了對於不理不睬的孩童做出指示的呼喚，幫助人們吧，傾聽上主的聲音，打開你的心靈，在這裡將自己交託出去，與上主交談。
