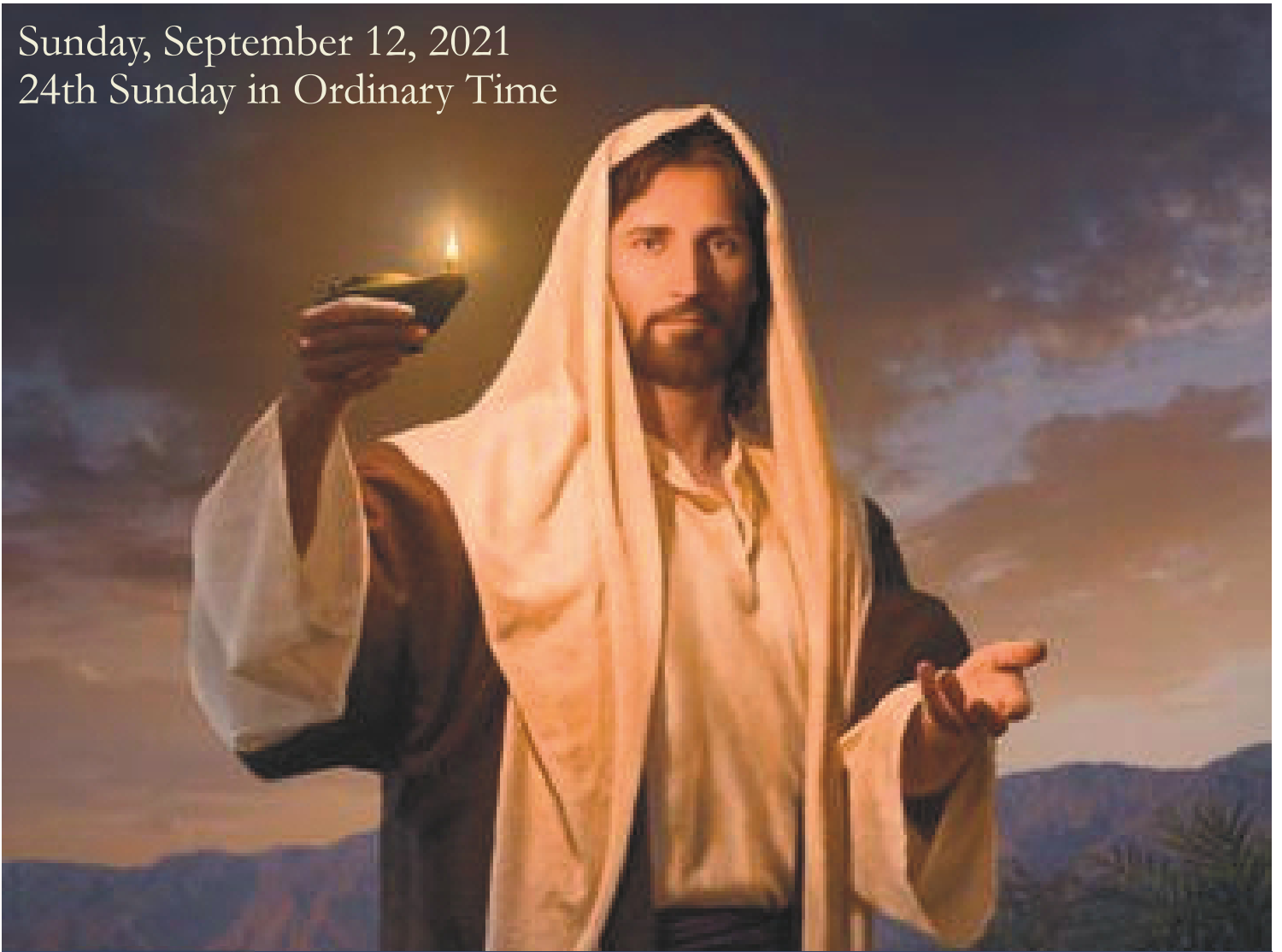

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION



Jesus addresses His disciples saying, “Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me.” We are Jesus’ disciples, and He is speaking those same words to us here and now.

Living a life of discipleship is not always easy. It requires us to be imitators of Christ — who suffered, died, and rose from the dead out of total love for each one of us. This means we are called to share in Christ’s sufferings by taking up our cross and following Him daily. But what does this look like in our day-to-day lives?

We can start by making a firm resolution to follow Christ today, here and now, and renewing that resolution each day when we rise. This requires time with Him each day — speaking and listening.

We should also strive to pick up our crosses each day with Christ by our side. Our cross might be suffering from an illness, fighting an addiction, a day of screaming kids, or a period where things just don’t seem to go our way. Instead of avoiding these sufferings or complaining about them, we are called to carry them with Christ, allowing Him to transform us through them.

If we live life constantly focused on us, we will ultimately lose ourselves, but if we surrender our lives for Christ and His mission, we will gain eternal life and become more alive than we could have ever imagined, “For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it.” This takes daily commitment and requires endurance in our faith, which can only be done through active discipleship.

STEWARDSHIP RENEWAL

In the past two Sunday bulletins (August 29 and September 5), on page three, information was provided to help us understand what Stewardship is and set the stage for the Cathedral Stewardship Renewal journey that occurs over three Sundays in September. (If you missed reading these bulletins, you will find them in the Bulletin Archive on the Cathedral website at <https://is.gd/bulletinarchive>).

FIRST SUNDAY -- INTRODUCTION TO RENEWAL

Today, the Cathedral kicks off its parish Stewardship Renewal, a time that helps us strengthen our faith by discerning how we are currently investing our time, talent, and treasure. During his homily, Father O'Reilly introduces us to Renewal by explaining it is an opportunity to prayerfully recommit ourselves to God by thanking Him for the gifts He has given us.

To assist us in this recommitment, Father informs us to be on the lookout for a packet arriving in the U.S. mail soon and encourages us to carefully review these materials to determine how God is calling us to take steps to grow in our faith in the coming year. This packet contains:

- ◆ Cover letter from Father
- ◆ Stewardship brochure educating us on the meaning of stewardship
- ◆ Ministry Catalog that describes the Cathedral ministries, and
- ◆ Commitment Card to make for spiritual growth by committing to giving of our time, talent, and treasure.

SECOND SUNDAY – LAYWITNESS TALKS AND MINISTRY FAIR

On the Second Renewal Sunday, the 19th, we will hear from a parishioner who will briefly share how he/she has grown in faith by embracing stewardship as a way of life and grown closer to God as a result. Following Mass, we are invited to attend the Ministry Fair in Mercy Hall to learn more about our parish ministries. This will help us determine which ministry we could offer our talent. Also, this is an opportunity to enjoy refreshments and share fellowship with our parish brothers and sisters.

THIRD SUNDAY – COMMITMENT SUNDAY

On September 26, our Renewal journey culminates with Commitment Sunday. On this day, we will bring our Commitment Card to Mass. During Mass, as a parish community, we will offer God our individual gifts of time, talent, and treasure for the coming year.

Throughout this Renewal journey, consider all that God has blessed us with and how we can use these blessings to serve Him. Our goal as a Cathedral parish is to be a Stewardship Parish – a community who is noticeably committed to prayer, parish ministry, and generous financial support. May God bless you as you discern how He is calling you to grow closer to Him this year.

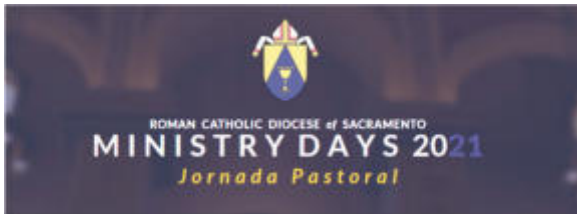

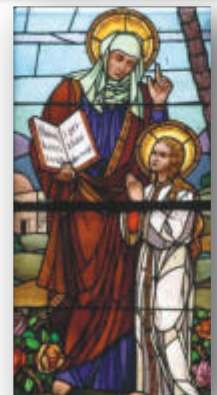

Can You Walk the Walk?

I've met and talked with enough people to feel confident that if you polled 100 fallen-away Catholics about why they didn't want anything to do with the Church, the term "accountability" would pop up in almost all of their answers.

And to be fair, a lack of accountability isn't just a Catholic problem. Talking the talk but not walking the walk has been a shortcoming handed down throughout the ages, across all creeds and nationalities.

Loving our neighbor, welcoming the stranger, clothing the naked, feeding the poor — it all sounds fantastic, especially when we're the ones saying it.

But the doing — well, that's a different story, isn't it? We would do well to remember that Christ calls one of his best friends "Satan" when Peter tries to convince Jesus to stray from his destiny.

Have you ever been called Satan by one of your good buddies? I'll bet it's not a great feeling. But think about what Peter was doing. He had just said, "You are the Christ." And now, mere moments later, he's saying: "Don't say these things. Don't say you're going to suffer. Don't say you'll be killed." He was telling Christ to squander what the Lord had given him. He was telling him that having faith was fine, but being faithful? It's just a little too hard. God has a destiny for you, too, and He's asking you to be open to it. Maybe it's not in your comfort zone. Maybe you don't think you can do it. Lord, give us faith — but help us, also, to do the work.
