## PENTECOST-THE GIFT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The word Pentecost is Greek and it means "50th day." Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and their followers, and the beginning of their Earthly ministry to make disciples of all nations.

"Knowledge of faith is possible only in the Holy Spirit: to be in touch with Christ, we must first have been touched by the Holy Spirit. He comes to meet us and kindle faith in us." (CCC, 683)

"Come, Holy Spirit!" Yes, in any discernment of God's call, we need to call on the Holy Spirit to come to fill and inspire us. Do we think to call on the Holy Spirit? Pentecost reminds us to do this not just on one feast during the year . . . but every day. Pentecost is also a Jewish holiday, which the Jews use to celebrate the end of Passover. Jews celebrate the gift of the law to Moses at Mt. Sinai on this day. But we, as Catholics celebrate the birth of our Church. Happy Birthday to us, the Church!

At Pentecost, the Apostles and their followers were gathered in the upper room. Jews from all over the world were gathered with Peter, the leader of the Apostles and the Eleven. At this time, a great wind blew and a flame appeared as a tongue of fire, which split itself into many individual flames above the heads of all those present. The Holy Spirit came upon these people and each began to speak in tongues. Despite the fact many had no common language, they were perfectly able to understand one another.

- RCIA is a process of study, exploration, faith-sharing, and faith formation with specific liturgical rites for seekers and inquirers. As they become more certain of the teachings of the Catholic faith, they decide for themselves to continue their journey to the Sacraments.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost today, we are reminded once more of the great vocation to which God has called each one of us. As the Holy Spirit fills us, the Church, we become co-workers in the great mission to spread the Gospel and work signs and wonders. We might believe that spreading the Gospel and working signs and wonders is for a select few, but it is the work of every baptized Christian. We may have been taught that all we are called to do is simply pursue our interests and wait for Jesus to return. But through the power of the Holy Spirit, each one of us is challenged to live out the gifts we've been given in order to share the Good News and reveal Christ's Kingdom. There is no other pursuit in life greater than this, and any other pursuit is a waste of time and life.

Pentecost is the birth of the Church, the birth of a new Humanity, in which we are impelled to do one thing, reveal Christ and His kingdom. The grace from the Spirit to work with Christ, raises us up to see the great dignity of the Human family. We are not enslaved in sin, we are not unworthy, we are not lost, we are not alone. We are co-workers with Christ and co-heirs to His kingdom. As members of the Body, filled with the Holy Spirit, we instinctively use our talents, time, and treasures for the only reality that matters, Christ and His kingdom. To resist this calling is to live a life of pain and frustration, a life of darkness and death. Much of our time is spent in resisting this calling. Much of society encourages resistance, still enslaved in old, tired sins that gasp to maintain a hold on us. The Spirit, however, is too strong and continues to impel us to work with Christ and for Christ. Do not resist the Spirit that is within you! Live!

# HAPPY PENTECOST!

Those of us in ministry love this saying:  
God doesn't call the equipped. He  
equips the called.

We all know that sort of queasy feeling  
we get in the pit of our stomachs when  
it becomes clear what we're supposed  
to do, in any situation. It's that feeling  
of: Oh, no. Not me. Not now. I can't.

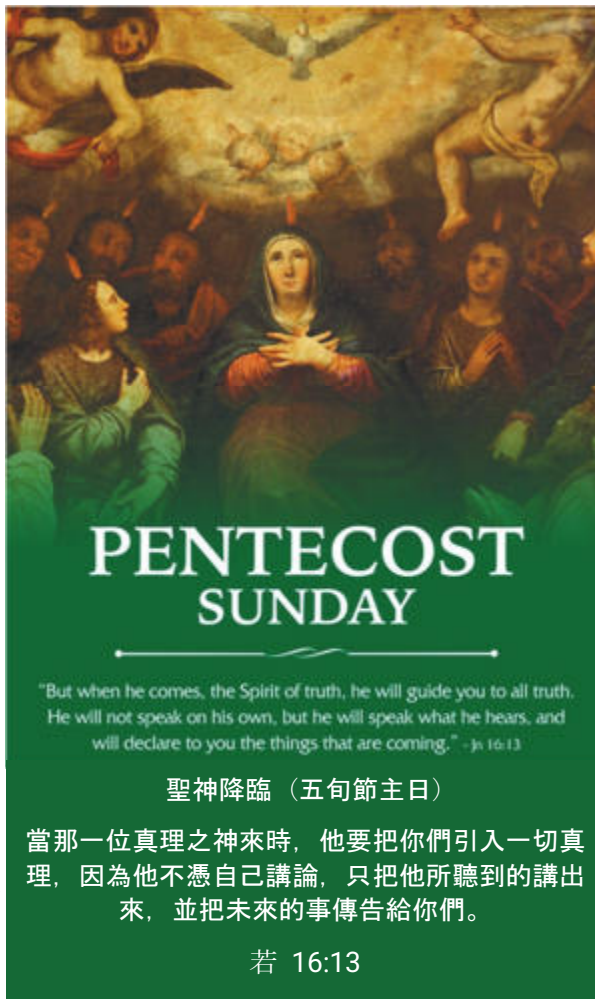
We've all got our list of reasons why not,  
don't we? We do it for everything, from  
big life problems to small everyday  
choices. I'm not going to invite my  
neighbor to church because I don't want  
to come across as pushy. I'm not going  
to make amends with my cousin be-  
cause she'll just walk all over me again.  
I'm not going to say a Rosary tonight  
because I'm tired and it'll just stress me  
out.

However, even if we all put our lists of  
"reasons why we can't" together, I don't  
think any of us have reasons quite as  
valid as the apostles. Their job was to

convert the nations — and here they are, a bunch of fisher-  
men who haven't been out of Judea, who speak only their  
own languages. Were they supposed to preach the Gospel  
via a particularly compelling game of charades? But even that  
big, giant, stop-you-dead-in-your tracks Reason Why We  
Can't was nothing, because God had a plan. He didn't call a  
bunch of equipped men. He called them, and He equipped  
them. Cue the tongues of fire!

God doesn't call us to do His will because we have what it  
takes. He calls us because He's ready to give us what it takes.  
Being a good steward is to answer the call of Christ knowing  
he will provide.

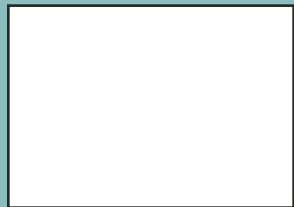

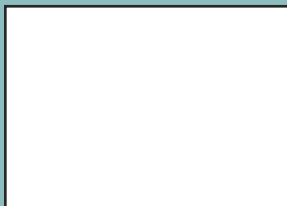

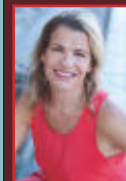
