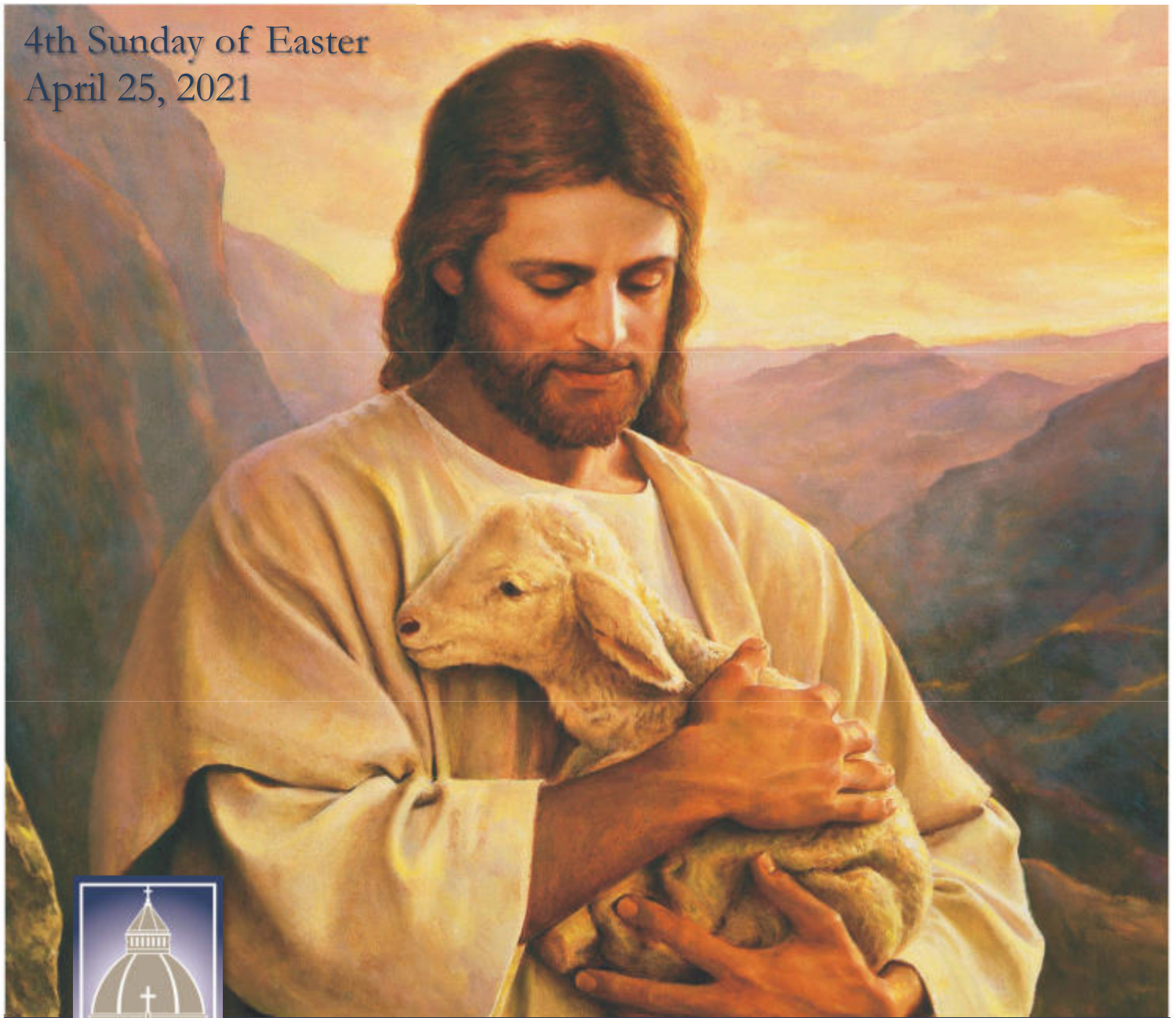

- The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, or RCIA, is a communal process for formal initiation of new members into the Catholic Church.
- RCIA is a process of study, exploration, faith-sharing, and faith formation with specific liturgical rites for seekers and inquirers. Seekers and inquirers are non-baptized adults who desire to be fully initiated into the Roman Catholic Church and/or baptized adult Christians who desire full communion in the Roman Catholic Church.

The purpose of World Day of Prayer for Vocations is to publicly fulfill the Lord's instruction to, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). As a climax to a prayer that is continually offered throughout the Church, it affirms the primacy of faith and grace in all that concerns vocations to the priesthood and to the consecrated life. While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the ordained ministries (priesthood and diaconate), consecrated life in all its forms (male and female religious life, societies of apostolic life, consecrated virginity), secular institutes in their diversity of services and membership, and to the missionary life.

LECCION GENERAL

CREO

Cuando recitamos el Credo de los Apóstoles, decimos: “creo en la santa Iglesia católica”. Esto significa que creemos que Jesús estableció una Iglesia santa para toda la humanidad. Esto no sugiere que las otras religiones o denominaciones (sobre todo las denominaciones cristianas) no contengan algunos elementos de la verdad. Lo que significa es que, según el Decreto sobre el ecumenismo del Concilio Vaticano II: “Solamente por medio de la Iglesia católica de Cristo, que es auxilio general de la salvación, puede conseguirse la plenitud total de los medios salvíficos”. Las cuatro marcas (atributos o características) de la Iglesia, es decir, que es una, santa, católica y apostólica, nos indican que la Iglesia Católica es la Iglesia que Jesucristo fundó. Jesús le dio a la Iglesia estas características por medio del Espíritu Santo.

PALABRAS A SABER

The Creed and the Four Marks of the Church

LESSON SUMMARY

I BELIEVE

When we recite the Apostles’ Creed, we say that we “believe in the holy catholic Church.” This means that we believe that Jesus established one true Church for all of humanity. It is not to imply that other faiths (especially other Christian faiths) do not contain elements of truth. But it is to say that, according to the Vatican Council’s Decree on Ecumenism: “It is through Christ’s Catholic Church alone, which is the universal help toward salvation, that the fullness of the means of salvation can be obtained.” We know by the Church’s four marks (traits or characteristics) — the Church is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic — that the Catholic Church is the Church that Jesus Christ founded. Jesus gives these traits to the Church through the Holy Spirit.

WORDS TO KNOW

Marks of the Church the traits or characteristics by which we know the church. The four marks of the church are: one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic.

Holy sacred, dedicated to God.

Catholic universal in the sense of being whole and complete, and for all nations.

Apostolic founded by Christ on the apostles and govern through their successors, the bishops.

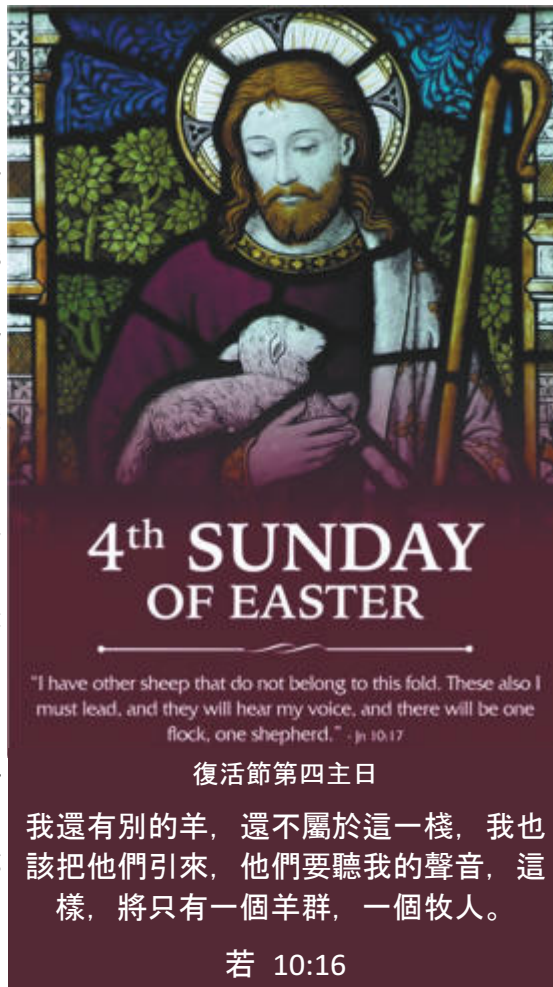
Sure, venting is helpful. We all need that friend or family member who can listen to our problems. But if we ever start to think that person can solve them, it's a good sign that we're losing perspective.

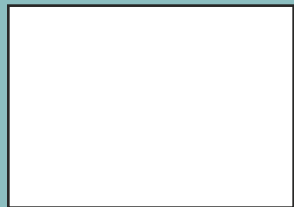

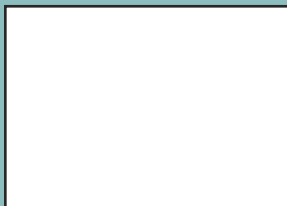

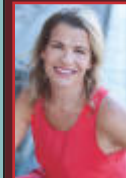
